

Shepherd's Thoughts

GOSPELMk 13:33-37

Be watchful! You do not know when the Lord of the house is coming.

Good is good, all the time! All the time God is good!

Advent Season marks the new beginning in our Church liturgical calendar. It is from where we restart our clock of waiting in preparation for the second coming of our Lord, Jesus Christ. The first Advent happened 2023 years ago and the first fruit of man's joyful waiting was a blessed first Christmas, when Christ was born.

"Be watchful!" Our hour of waiting has not ended yet. Let's continuously reset our alarm of consciousness to be always joyfully awakened for the second coming of the Lord. So, that this coming Christmas be meaningful and touch more people's lives towards more appreciation of God's love, let's wait together, come together, and meet Christ together this Christmas!
