From the Deacon's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I hope you all survived the bitter cold last week. Hopefully we will get a little reprieve this week. I wonder how our current weather pattern fits in with climate change or global warming. In our second reading today, St. Paul wrote in his first letter to the Corinthians; "the world in its present form is passing away". I have a feeling he was speaking more on an eternal or spiritual level though. I remember hearing my dad say many times that the world is changing so fast or that the world certainly isn't the same as when he was young. The world is constantly changing. This is undoubtedly true. It has been true and will continue to be true for every generation. Many of the changes that we have witnessed in our lifetime have made the world a much better place. "The world in its present form is passing away". The world we live in today is only our temporary home and it will pass away. The world we look forward to is our eternal home with God in heaven!
