

# Shepherd's Thoughts

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the Holy Week. As we remember Jesus' triumphant entry to Jerusalem, like the people then, we also wave our palm praising Jesus with a loud voice, "Hosanna to the Son of David! blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! the King of Israel, Hosanna in the highest!"

As we celebrate this Sunday of the Passion of Jesus, we also recall how people exalted him, hosanna to Son of David, hosanna to the King! But when they handed him over to Pilate, all their praises had been turned into mockery on the day of his suffering, they shouted in a loud voice, crucify him! crucify him! crucify him! So Jesus was scourged and handed him over to be crucified.

The people who praised him, hosanna to the King! were the same people who mocked him to be crucified! How about us, can we consider ourselves one of those praising God only by name and words but mocking him at the bottom of our hearts every time we repeatedly transgress his divine will?

Jesus' image as a Servant-God was truly manifested the moment he accepted with courage human suffering until death. As Paul beautifully expresses in the second reading today, "though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness;...he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross (Phil 2:6-11). May our constant reception of the Holy Eucharist that makes this act of redemption always present in our midst gives us courage to continue his mission.

Though he suffered and died, his perfect act of humility became the source of salvation for all who believe in his resurrection. Thus, as we humbly observe this Holy Week, we may also learn to value the significance of this celebration in our lives. As we participate with the Church's liturgical activities within this Holy Week, let this be our continued journey of faith to face hardships in life as Jesus humbly faced death on the cross for us.

Redeemed by the body and blood of Christ, may we be filled with this grace of redemption and be led to a meaningful celebration of his glorious resurrection.
