

Shepherd's Thoughts

God is good, all the time! All the time, God is good!

Jesus is risen today! Happy Easter to All! Jesus indeed is the main reason for all of us to celebrate with great joy this Sunday of Easter! Today, people who lived in darkness have seen a great light! Jesus who is the light of the world continuously overcomes the darkness of sin and death for us.

The glorious resurrection of Jesus remains to be the undefeated truth at all times! To believe in His resurrection is life. It's not a matter for debate but a truth to live by. There are still many people who don't believe in him but truly they cannot disprove this truth of his resurrection.

Christian Theology acknowledges the truth about the resurrection of Christ as the "Central Mystery of the Christian Faith". Our Catholic Christian faith is worthless if Jesus had not been raised from the dead. His resurrection became the strong foundation of our Church.

As we celebrate Christ's mystery of the resurrection we also highlight the meeting or

"SALUBONG": An Encounter of the Risen Christ and the Blessed Mother, Mary (A Filipino Way of Sharing and Celebrating Easter leading to First Easter Morning Eucharist)

It is an Easter Tradition in the Philippines that reenacts the meeting of the Risen Christ and the Blessed Virgin Mary, his Mother, on the First Easter morning. There is no biblical account on this meeting, but this remains as an Oral Tradition. What we can only fine in the Bible (Written Tradition), are the proofs serving as the bases of our belief that Jesus has truly risen on the third day after his suffering and death on the cross.

# What are the proofs of Jesus' Resurrection?

- 1. The Empty Tomb
- 2. The proclamation of the Angels
- 3. Appearance of Jesus to Mary Magdalena
- 4. The Sequence of Jesus Post- Resurrection Appearances to his Apostles
  - 5. Testimonies of his disciples
  - 6. Gospel account from the Bible
  - 7. Oral Preachings of the Apostles
  - 8. Testimonies of the Saints
  - 9. Historical facts and evidences
  - 10. Authority Teachings of the Church
- 11. Oral Tradition (transmission of the Christian faith through human communication wherein knowledge, art, ideas and cultural material is received, preserved, and transmitted orally from one generation to another)

Our Sacred Tradition explains to us that, if Jesus has been raised from the dead and truly appeared to Mary Magdalene and to his Apostles, isn't it impossible that Jesus did not appear to his mother? Thus, the "Salubong" gives highlight to this meeting between the Resurrected Christ and his mother. On this celebration, an Easter Angel plays an important role, representing the Angel on the resurrection account, who appeared and announced to Mary Magdalene and to his Apostles the good news that Jesus is risen!

May we not only experience the joy of Easter in our hearts but as we continually live with the grace of Easter may we also bring Christ to those who until now cannot believe that truly He is risen!
