Shepherd's Thoughts

Happy Easter! Let us proclaim the mystery of our faith: Jesus Christ, who was crucified, is truly risen. Peter boldly declares, "We are witnesses of all that he did... They put him to death by hanging him on a tree" (Acts 10:39). The Resurrection does not wipe out the reality of the Cross; rather, it gives deeper meaning. The same Jesus who suffered injustice and death is now revealed as Lord of life. God's saving plan unfolds not through power as the world understands it, but through faithful love that triumphs over death.

The Responsorial Psalm reminds us: "The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone" (Ps 118:22). What the world rejected—Jesus' humility, obedience, and self-giving love—God has made the foundation of salvation. Easter assures us that no rejection, failure, or suffering is wasted when placed in God's hands. What seems like an end can become a beginning in Christ.

Saint Paul challenges us with the consequences of the Resurrection: "If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above" (Col 3:1). Easter is not only something we celebrate; it is a life we are called to live. Raised with Christ, we are invited to let go of sin, fear, and hopelessness, and to live with hearts fixed on what is eternal—love, mercy, and truth.

At the empty tomb, in the Gospel, the angel proclaims words meant for every generation: "Do not be afraid... He is not here, for he has been raised" (Mt 28:5-6). Easter dispels darkness and fear. Christ is alive, walking with us, and calling us this day and beyond to be witnesses in sharing Jesus, the risen Lord into a wounded world.

Prayer:

Risen Lord, open our hearts to the power of Your Resurrection. Strengthen our faith, cast out our fears, and help us seek what is above. May our lives bear witness that You are truly alive, now and forever. Amen.
