Shepherd's Thoughts

God is good, all the time! All the time, God is good!

When I was a child, every time I heard the word "Trinidad" (Trinity), I thought it was simply an ordinary woman's name because we had a relative-neighbor named Trining derived from the Spanish word "Trinidad". But as I grew older, I gradually came to understand its deeper meaning. It refers not merely to a name, but to the mystery of our Almighty God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: the Most Holy Trinity.

As I continued to grow in faith, I also came to realize that the God whom we adore today is the same God who revealed Himself to Moses in the first reading: "Having come down in a cloud, the Lord stood with Moses there and proclaimed His name, 'LORD'" (Ex 34:5). God did not remain distant or hidden; He desired to make Himself known to His people both in His holy name and His loving presence.

How blessed we are because God has revealed not only His name, but His very being to us: the Father as Creator, the Son as Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit as Sanctifier. This is why the Responsorial Psalm leads us to praise and worship Him: "Glory and praise forever!" (Dn 3:52). The Holy Trinity is not merely a doctrine we learn, but a mystery of love that we encounter and live every day.

Many saints and theologians, such as Gregory of Nazianzus and John of Damascus, attempted to help explain the mystery of the Holy Trinity through simple images. One beautiful example is the image of the sun. The Father can be compared to the sun itself—the source. The Son can be compared to the light that proceeds from the sun, revealing and illuminating all things. The Holy Spirit can be compared to the warmth we feel from the sun, touching and giving life to the world. While no analogy can fully explain the mystery of God, this image helps us understand that although the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons, they remain one in substance, one in essence, and perfectly united in love.

Every time we celebrate the Holy Mass, we begin with these familiar words: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (2 Cor 13:13). We hear these words so often that we may overlook their beauty. Yet they remind us that we live surrounded by the love of the Father, saved by the grace of the Son, and strengthened by the fellowship of the Holy Spirit.

Finally, the Gospel reveals the very heart of God's love: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life" (Jn 3:16). The mystery of the Trinity is ultimately the mystery of perfect love—a love that gives, saves, and remains with us forever.

May the Holy Trinity remind us that we are created not to live in isolation, but in communion—with God and with one another. Just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit live in perfect unity, may our families, communities, and hearts become reflections of that same love and unity.



Reflection Line:

The mystery of the Holy Trinity reminds us that God is not a God of distance, but a God of relationship, love, and communion.



Takeaway Thought:

The more we grow in our relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, the more we learn to live lives rooted in love, unity, and grace.
