Shepherd's Thoughts

God is good, all the time! All the time, God is good!

The readings this Sunday speak to us about trust, courage, and the unfailing love of God in the midst of life's trials and uncertainties.

In the first reading, the prophet Jeremiah finds himself surrounded by opposition, rejection, and suffering because of his faithfulness to God's call. Yet amid his struggles, he places his confidence in the Lord, proclaiming: "O Lord of hosts, You who test the just, who probe mind and heart" (Jer 20:12). Jeremiah reminds us that God knows our hearts, sees our struggles, and never abandons those who remain faithful to Him. Even when we feel misunderstood, discouraged, or burdened by life's challenges, the Lord remains our refuge and strength.

This trust is echoed in the Responsorial Psalm: "Lord, in your great love, answer me" (Ps 69:14). The psalmist cries out in prayer, confident that God's love is greater than every hardship. How often do we bring our fears, worries, and disappointments to the Lord? Today's psalm invites us to turn to Him with confidence, trusting that His love never fails and His mercy is always near.

In the second reading, Saint Paul reminds us of the greatest sign of God's love: "How much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many" (Rom 5:15). Through Christ, God's grace has been poured out abundantly upon us. Sin, suffering, and death do not have the final word. God's mercy is greater, and His love continues to overflow into our lives each day.

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks words that His disciples needed to hear and that we also need to hear today: "Do not be afraid" (Mt 10:31). The Lord knows that fear can easily take hold of our hearts—fear of failure, rejection, uncertainty, illness, loss, or the future. Yet Jesus reassures us that we are precious in God's eyes: "You are worth more than many sparrows" (Mt 10:31). If God lovingly cares for even the smallest creatures, how much more does He care for each one of us, Whom He has made in His image and likeness.

At the same time, Jesus calls us to remain faithful and courageous in living our faith. "Whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father" (Mt 10:33). Faith is not meant to remain hidden. We are called to witness to Christ through our words, our actions, and the way we live each day. In a world that often challenges Christian values, discipleship requires courage, perseverance, and trust in God.

As we celebrate this Eucharist, let us bring before the Lord our fears, anxieties, and burdens. May we find strength in His promises, confidence in His love, and courage to remain faithful witnesses of Christ. Let us remember that no matter what difficulties we face, we are never alone. The Lord knows us, loves us, and continually says to us: "Do not be afraid."

 Reflection Line:

The Lord knows every fear hidden in our hearts and gently reminds us that we are precious in His sight and never beyond His care.

 Takeaway Thought:

*When fear speaks, let faith answer: "I belong to God, and He will never abandon me."
