A zesty nose of fresh lime, lemon and grapefruit. Flavourful and persistent on the palate with notes of green melon and white peach, with a gentle hint of fennel on the finish.

Rich and well-rounded with a perfect balance between power and freshness owing to the structured yet elegant tannins of a classic Médoc.
