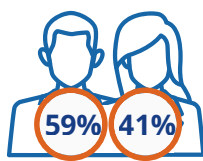

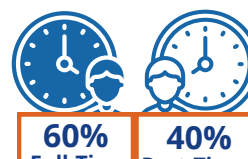

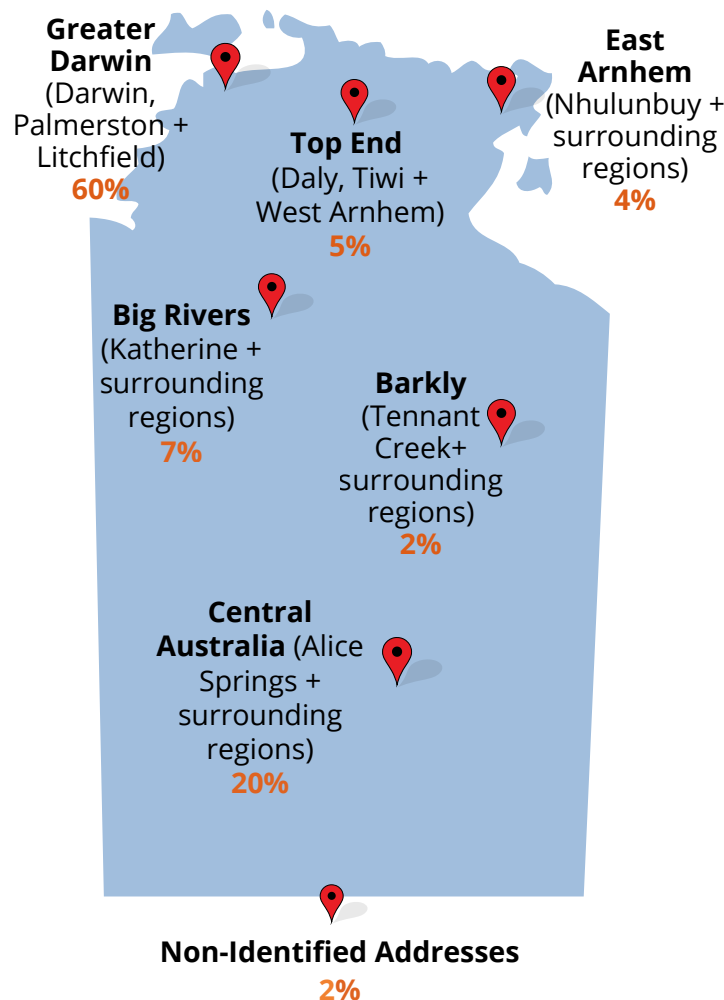

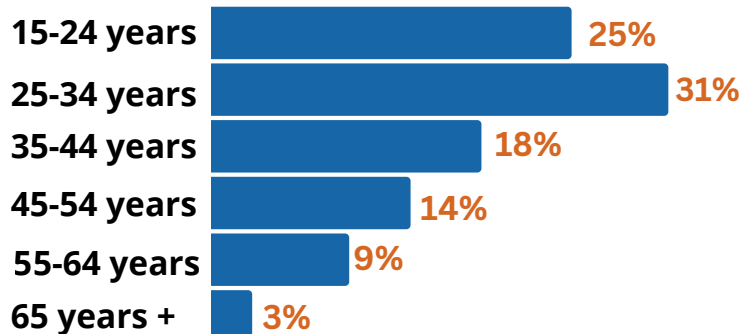

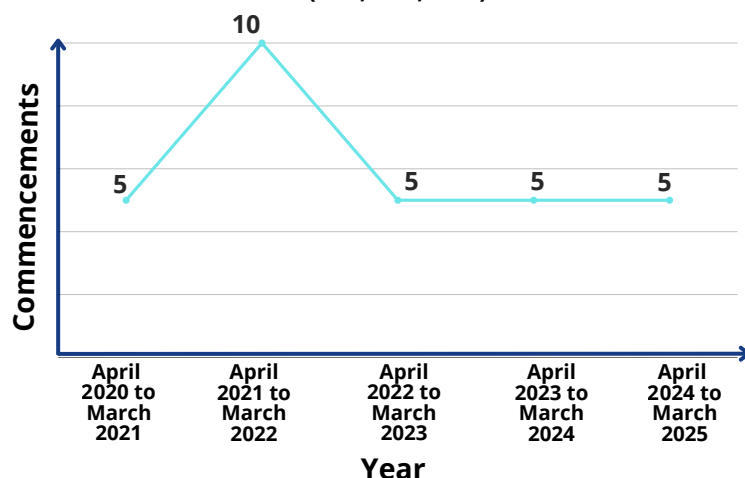

Food, Beverage and Pharmaceutical Training Package (FBP, FDF, SUG)

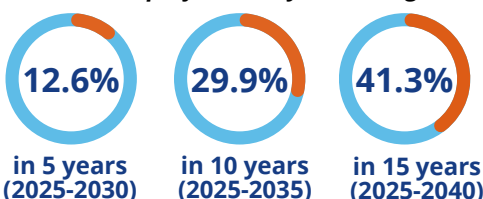
