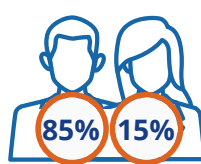

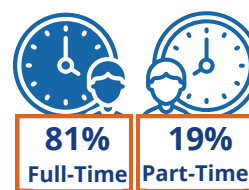

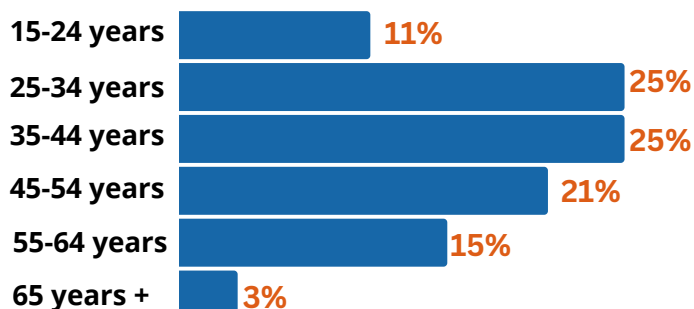

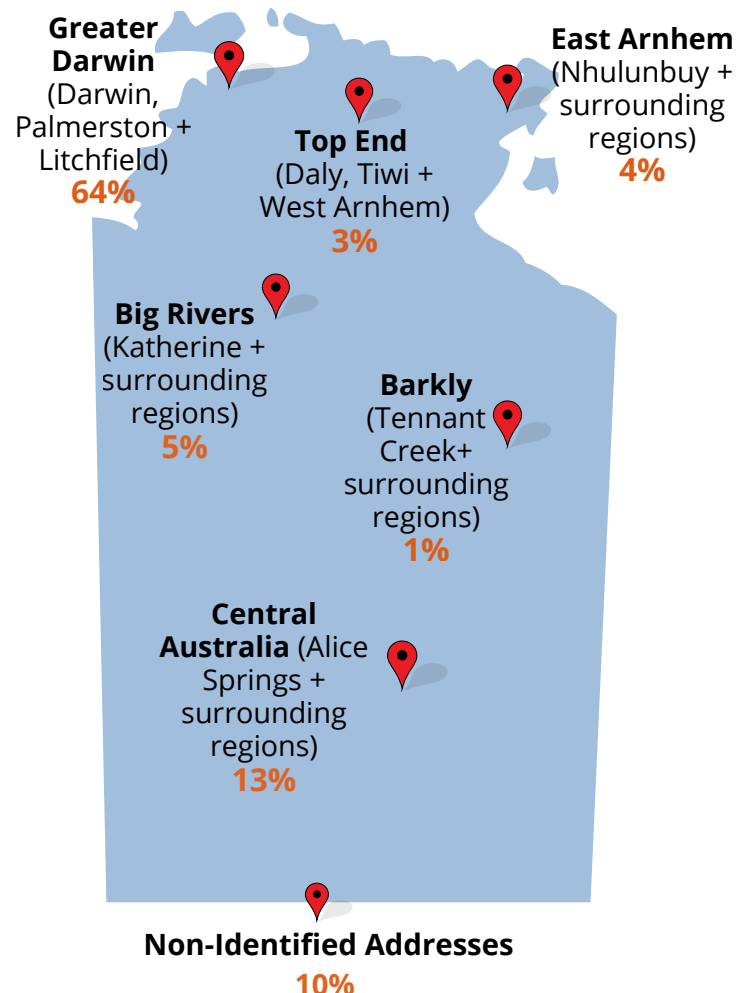

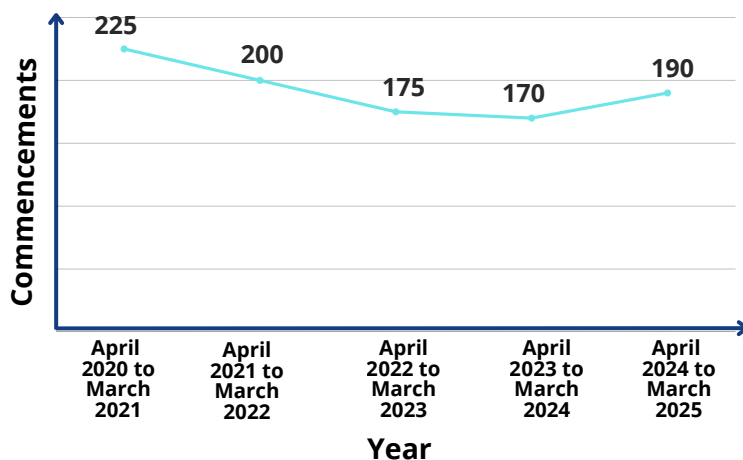
## Transferable Occupations

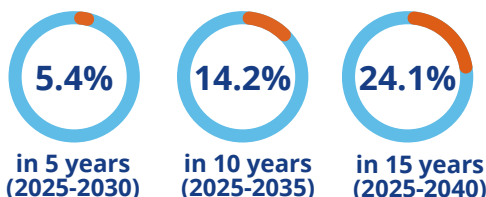

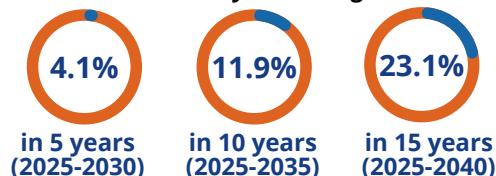
### Automation

The percentage of job tasks predicted to be performed by technologies

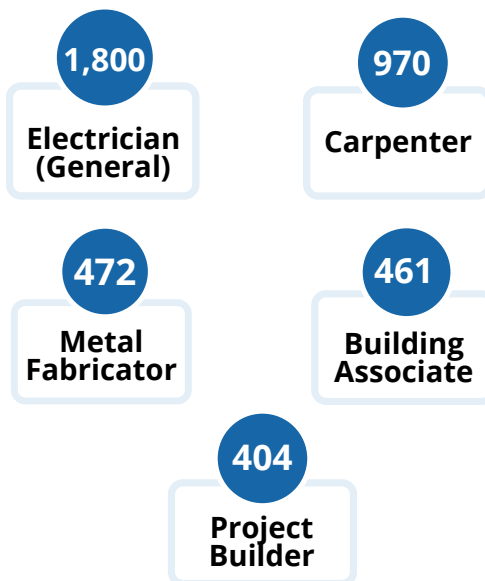


### Augmentation
