1. Acceptance of these terms

3. Privacy and cookies

If we collect personal information via the Website (including through cookies and similar technologies), we do so in accordance with our **Privacy Policy** (see the policy for details on what we collect, why, and your choices).

4. Intellectual property and permitted use

The Website and its content are protected by copyright and other rights owned by ISACNT or third parties. We grant you a personal, non-exclusive, revocable, non-transferable licence to access and
