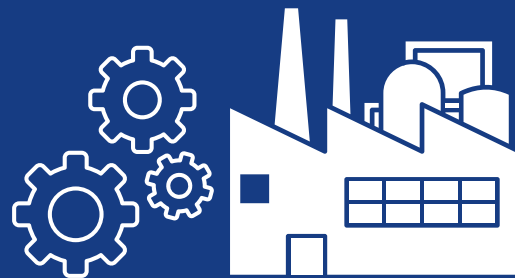

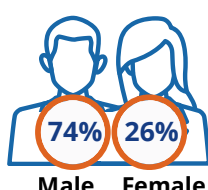

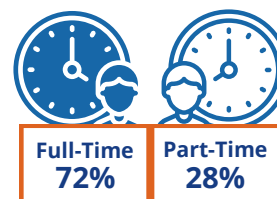
Persons Employed (February 2026)



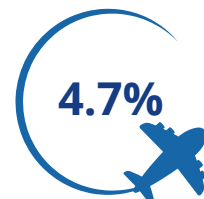

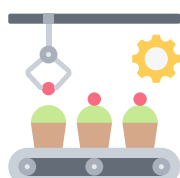

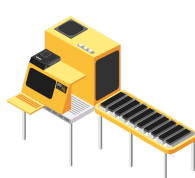
### Industry Employment: Top 3 Subsectors (February 2026)

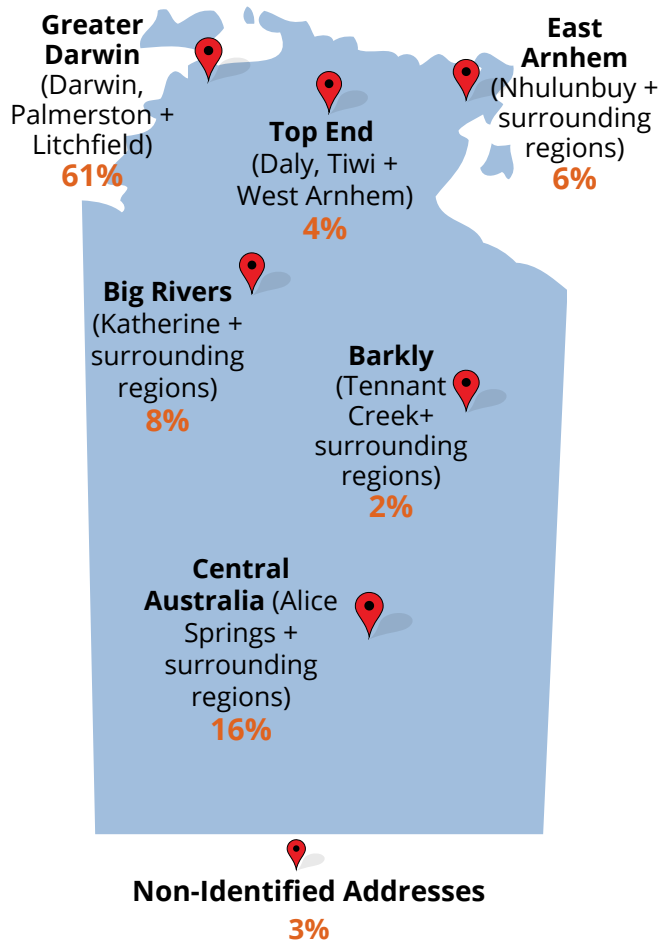


Food Product Manufacturing

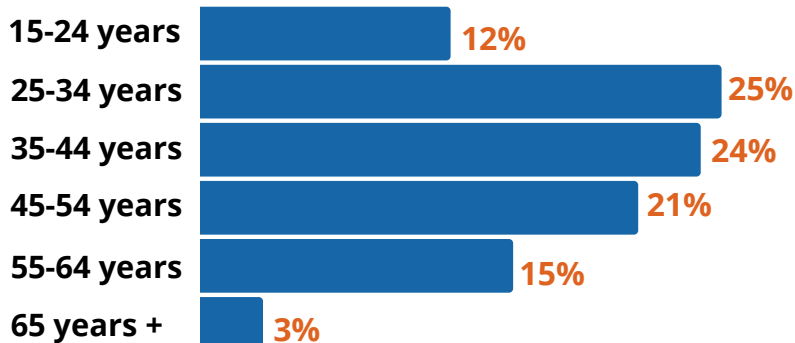

Electronic Instrument Trades Worker (General) → Electrician (General)

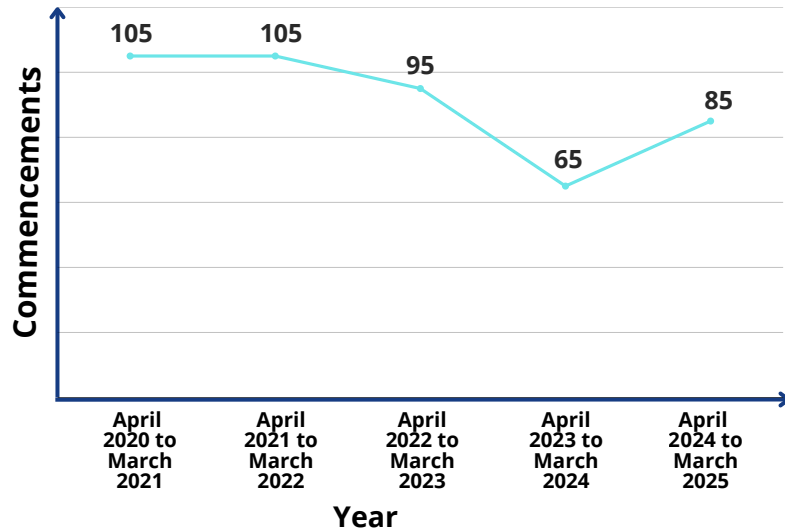
Product Assembler → Welder (First Class)

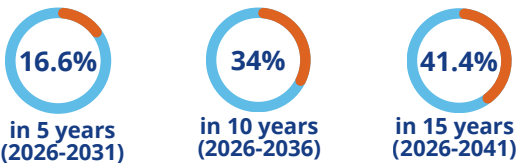

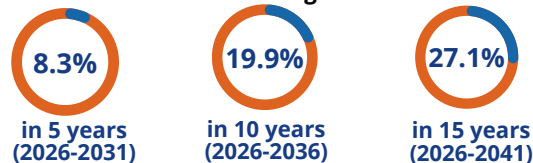
### Automation

The percentage of job tasks predicted to be performed by technologies

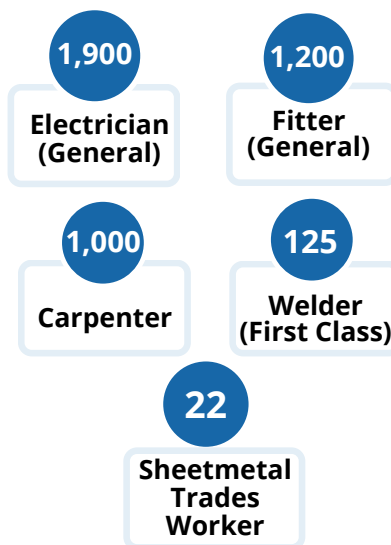


### Augmentation

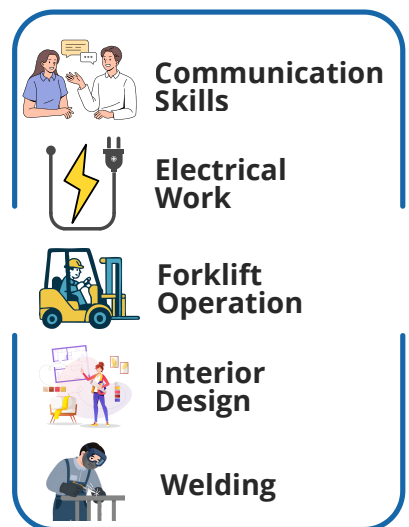
The percentage of value addition to job tasks by technologies
