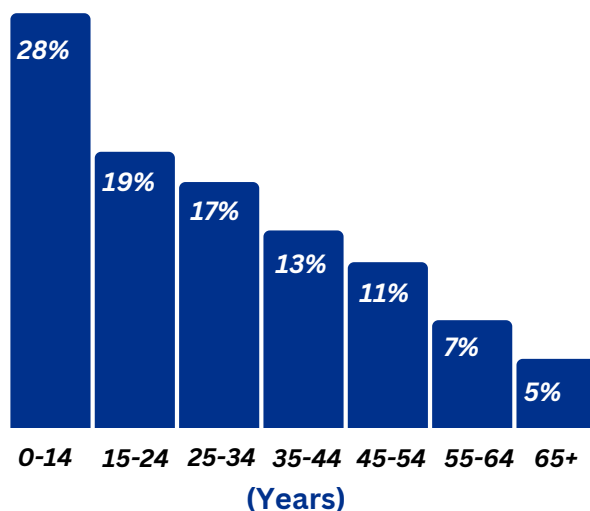
NT Indigenous Population (2021)

Total Resident Indigenous Population

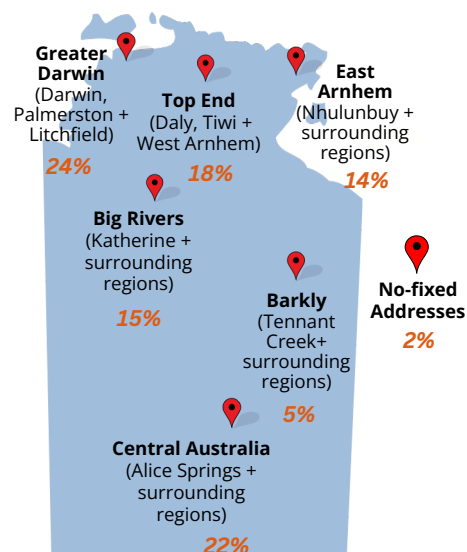

Age Cohort of Indigenous Population in the NT

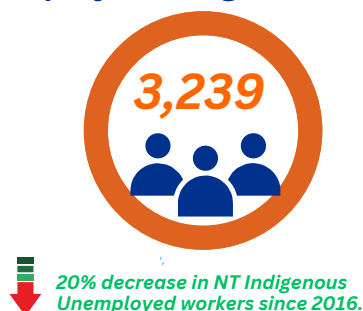


Indigenous Population by Region

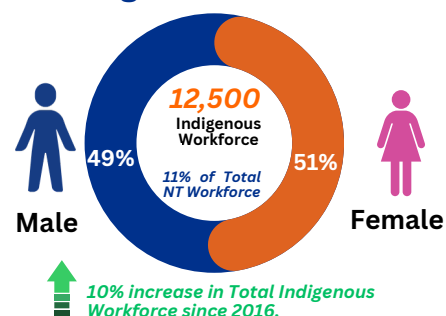

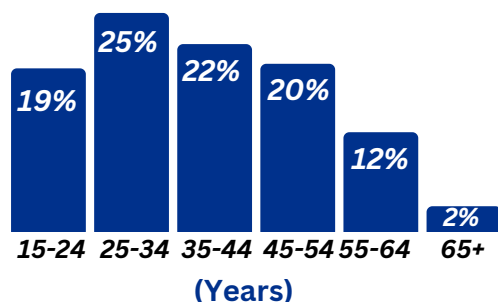

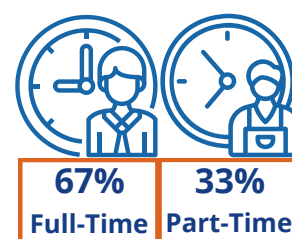

Indigenous Employment Status



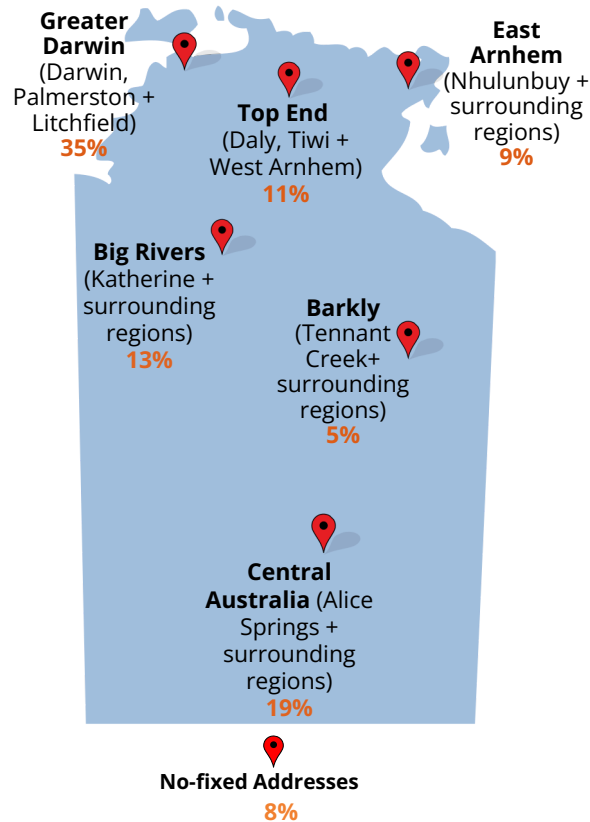

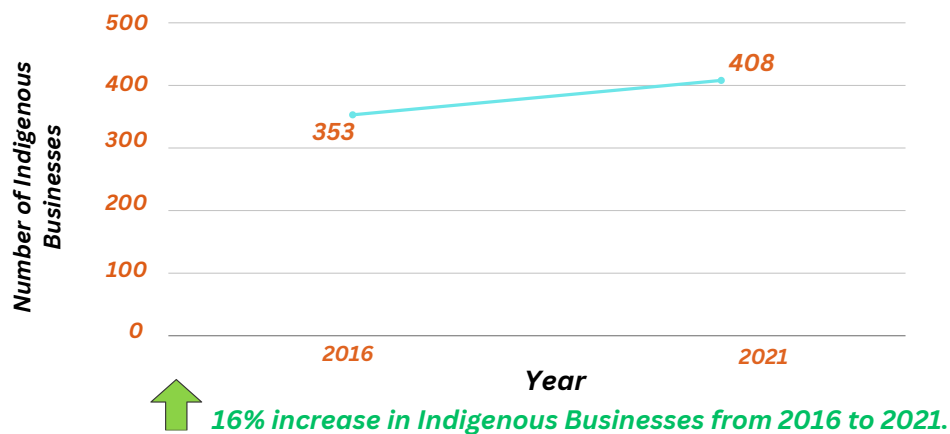
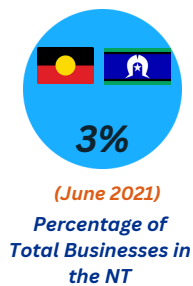

NT Indigenous Workers by Region (2021)

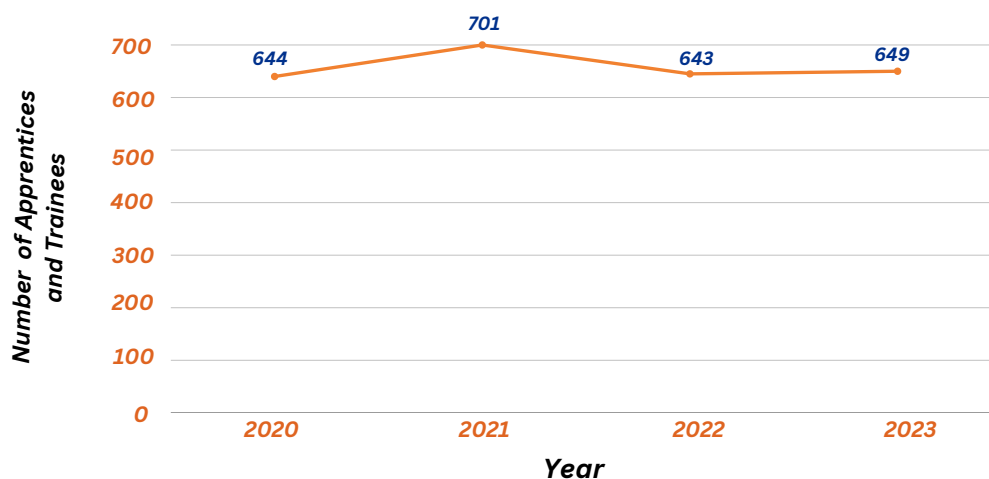


Total Indigenous Businesses in the NT
