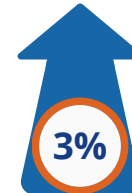
Value of the Industry (2023-2024)

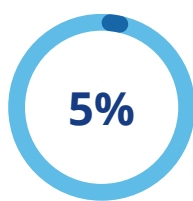
Total Registered Businesses (2025)



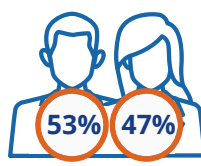
Increase in Registered Businesses (2024-2025)



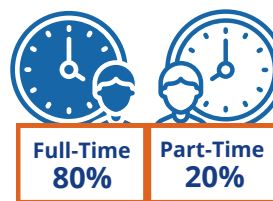
Industry Employment (February 2026)

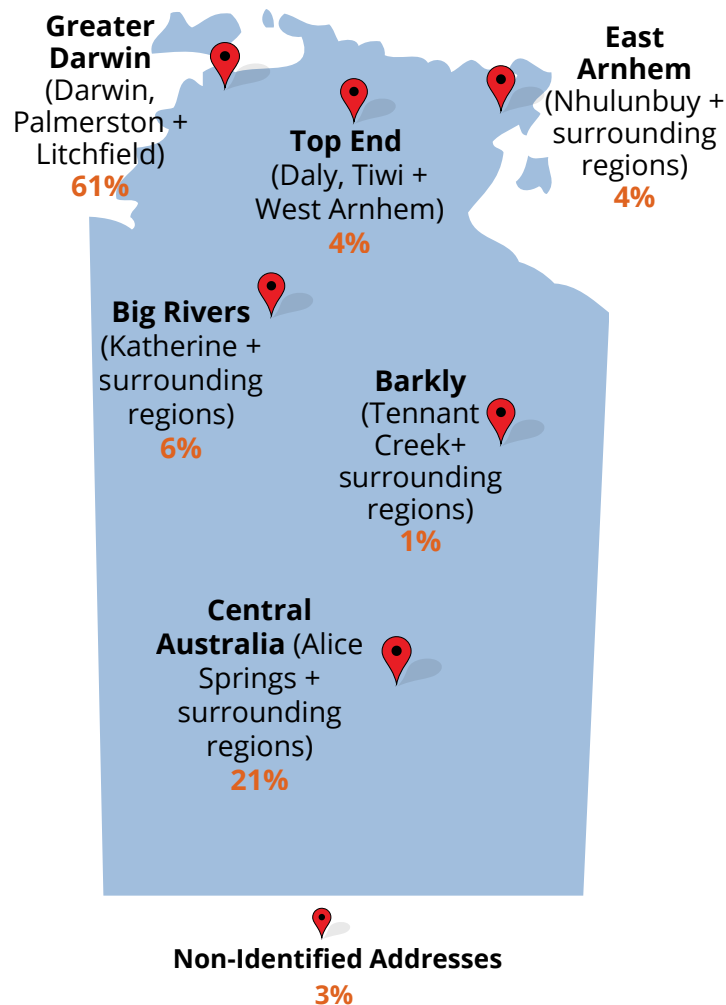

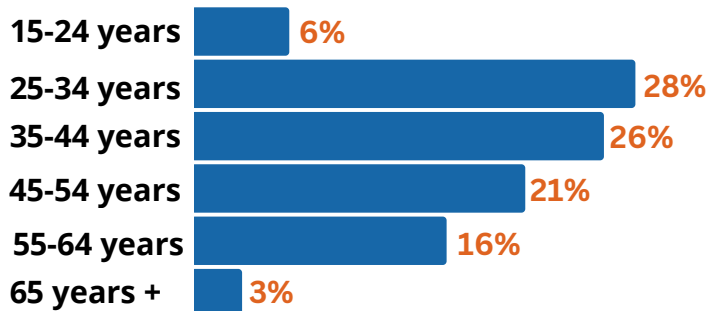

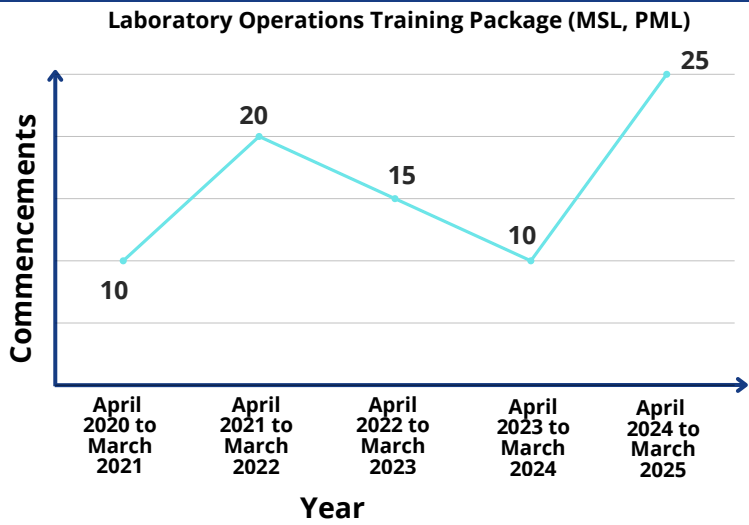

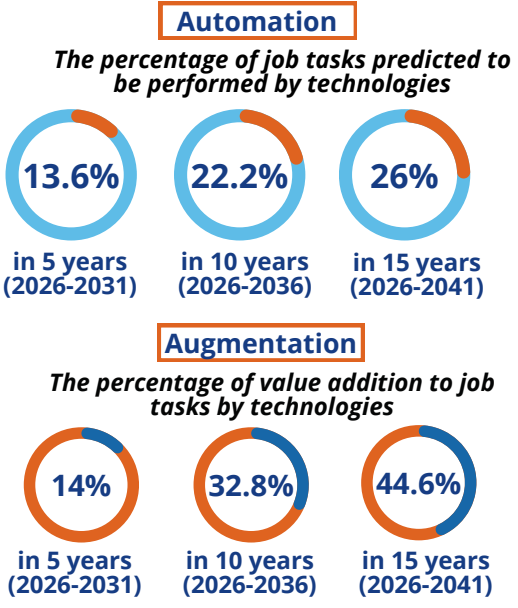
