

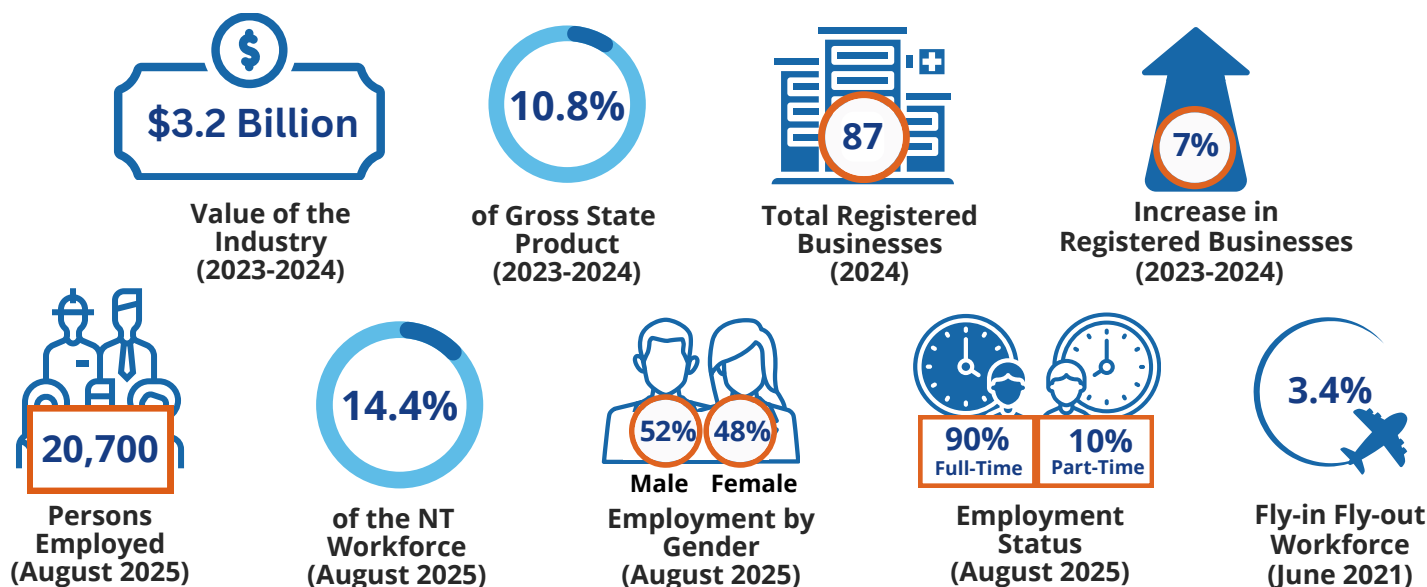
Public Administration and Safety

This industry provides services that support physical, social and economic interactions; general public safety and security services; and the enforcing of regulations.

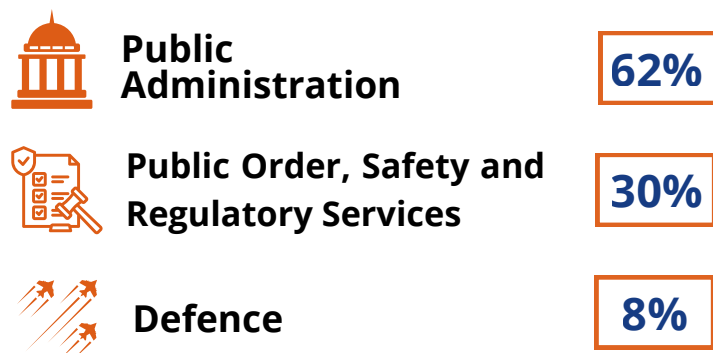


Northern Territory Workforce 2025

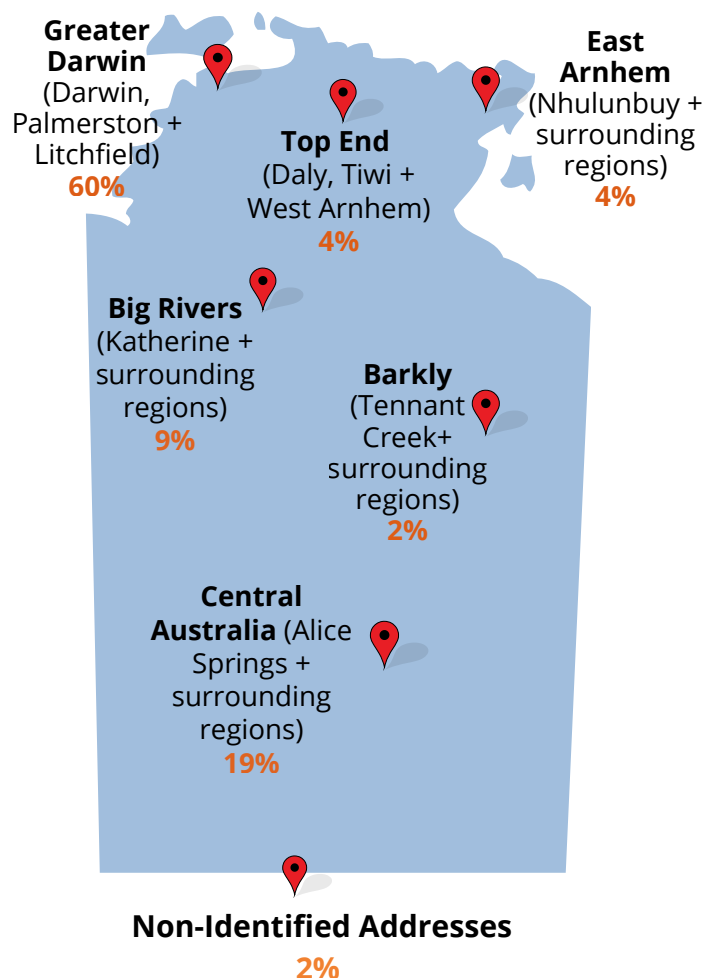
Economic Contribution to the NT



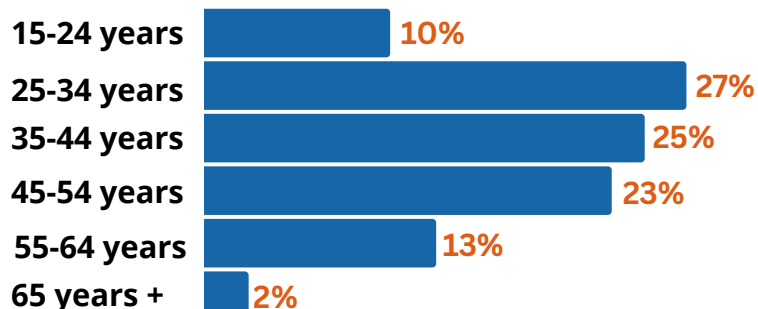
Industry Employment by Subsectors (August 2025)

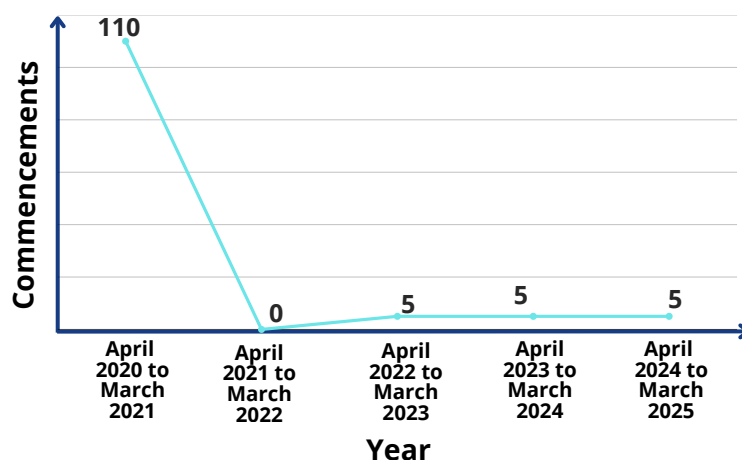
