Policy, systems, and environmental (PSE) interventions include updates to established guidelines, improvements to the way business is done, and alterations to the physical environment to support healthy behaviors and make the healthy choice the easy choice. In FFY 2024 Georgia SNAP-Ed had implemented a total of 185 different PSE Interventions which led to the adoption of 376 PSE Changes in the 14 Congressional Districts.

Direct Nutrition Education (DNE) classes are used to improve the likelihood that persons eligible for SNAP will make healthy food choices within a limited budget and choose physically active lifestyles consistent with the current Dietary Guidelines for Americans and the USDA food guidance. In Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2024, the Georgia SNAP-Ed Program reached 39,898 participants through DNE classes throughout the 14 congressional districts.
