MEN'S AND WOMEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS
4 STROKE ROUNDS
PLAYED OVER 72 HOLES

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

This event is open to all financial (on the day of the first round) Male and Female Full, Juniors and Colts members with a GA handicap. There are no restrictions on the length of time that the player has been a full financial member.

TEES

Division 1 (A Grade) and Division 2 (B Grade) Men's Play is from the Black Tees as set out on the day. Division 3 (C Grade) play will be from the Blue Tees as set out on the day. Women's Division will be played from the Red Tees.

FORMAT

This is a 72-hole stroke competition, played over 4 days, winners are the players with the lowest gross aggregate score and lowest Nett aggregate score in each grade.

TIES AFTER 72 HOLES

If after 72 holes of play there is a tie in any grade Gross Championship then there will be a sudden death playoff, with the following holes (10th, 9th, 1st, 18th and repeated until there is a result). A referee will be provided.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to all grade winners and runners-up in each of the grades. There will be a 72-hole nett winner & runner-up prize awarded in each A, B & C Grades. Ties other than first place will be decided by countback. Players are eligible for one major prize only.

LOCAL RULE

The competition will be subject to the Courses' Local Rules, as identified.



TEE TIME SLOTS

All Tee Bookings will be made through the ProShop or Through the online booking system.

No player/group is permitted to play prior to first tee time booking of 7am. Practice/Warm up is permitted.

If players do play before the first allocated time slot, they will not be eligible for the championships.

All groups will hit off at their designated tee time.

If players choose to miss their time slot because of weather or late team member, they must rebook the next free available tee time booked via the ProShop.

Players who fail to follow this policy may be subject to a 2-stroke penalty per player as per the discretion of the present members or available members of the Match Committee.

WET WEATHER

Unless a ruling is made by the present or available Match committee members to delay play, Rule 5.7a/1 Taking extended shelter from rain. This rule will apply.

Here are some other reasons to stop play:

- Visibility: If players cannot see the landing areas or read the line of play on the putting green due to fog or darkness
- Temporary water: If the area around the hole is covered in temporary water that cannot be removed.
- Wind: If several balls are being moved by the wind

If a player or group stops play, they should report to the Committee as soon as possible. If a player stops play for an unauthorised reason or does not report to the Committee, they may be disqualified.

PACE OF PLAY

Pace of Play will apply as per MGC general Terms of Competition.

SEEDDED DRAW - FINAL ROUND

There is a seeded draw in all grades for the final round, with the top 4 players (gross scores only) from each grade qualifying for the seeded positions. Players MUST play in their seeded positions to be eligible for their respective grade Club Championship.

TEE TIMES FOR THE SEEDDED ROUND

10:02 to 10:16am will be blocked out and not available for booking.

10:23am A Grade

10:30am B Grade

10:37am C Grade

10:44am Women's Grade

Note: Players do not have to play in seeded groups to be eligible for the nett prizes.



HANDICAPS

Handicap ranges that determine if a player will compete in A, B or C grade. As identified per MGC Slice/Slope adjustment of your official AGU rating.

A Grade +9.9 to 10.1 GA Handicap

B Grade 10.2 to 18.1 GA Handicap

C Grade 18.2 to 45 (Maximum daily handicap of 45)

Women's Division all handicaps (Maximum daily handicap of 54)

Players reducing or increasing their handicaps during the above competition will remain in the same grade in which they started. Handicaps will still be adjusted during the Club Championships.

There will also be an alternate Stableford competition available on all Saturdays for those not wishing to play Club Championships. This competition will be from the blue tees. Grades will be frozen from round one.

The Match Committee, Club Captain or authorised delegates reserve the right to alter or make any variations to the Conditions of Play, (including the number of rounds played), the fixtures program, the number of grades, or to the awarding of any trophy.

These Conditions of Play are to be read and interpreted in conjunction with the Rules of Golf, the local rules and general conditions of play of Maclean Golf Club.
