WORD OF LIFE

17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: THE BLESSING OF KNOWING WHERE THE TREASURE IS HIDDEN

"The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field." (Mt 13:44)

A Christian should get up every morning saying to himself: "How blessed am I!" not because things are going well financially, or because his health is always excellent, or even because there are no difficulties in his family. Luck comes (or blessings come) from having faith; from knowing that God exists, and that God is not only the Creator and the Lord, but also the Father full of love—who loves us as we are.

We may think that faith doesn't save us from difficulties, but that isn't true. No matter how bad a situation is, it could always be worse without faith in God. Faith helps us not to lose all hope, to fight, and not to give up. This is the only path to victory. If we didn't have faith, we would still have the same problems, or even greater ones, but we would probably not have the strength that comes from God to face those problems.

That is why we must consider faith to be a blessing. And we must take care of this faith, so that it isn't extinguished or become lukewarm; we must do everything not to lose it. For this, there is nothing better than prayer, since praying is to be in contact with God, the beginning and end of our faith. If we have doubts about faith, let's not rack our brains looking for explanations. Instead, let's pray more, go to communion more and become closer to the Lord.

Purpose: Be conscious of the blessing you have by having faith. Take care of this gift. Avoid putting yourself in situations that jeopardize it. Pray more and ask the Lord to increase your faith.

PALABRA DE VIDA

DOMINGO XVI DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO: LLA BENDICIÓN DE SABER DÓNDE ESTÁ EL TESORO

"El reino de los cielos se parece a un tesoro escondido en el campo: el que lo encuentra, lo vuelve a esconder, y, lleno de alegría, va a vender todo lo que tiene y compra el campo" (Mt 13, 44)

Un cristiano debería levantarse cada mañana diciéndose a sí mismo: "¡Qué suerte tengo!". Y no porque las cosas le vayan bien en lo económico, o porque su salud sea siempre excelente, o porque en su familia no existan dificultades. La suerte nos viene de tener fe, de saber que Dios existe y que ese Dios no sólo es el Creador y el Señor sino el Padre lleno de amor que nos quiere como somos. Puedes pensar que la fe no te ahorra dificultades. No es verdad, ya que cualquier situación por mala que sea es susceptible de empeorar y, probablemente, si no tuvieras fe tu situación sería aún peor. La fe al menos te sirve para no desesperar, para luchar, para no rendirte. Y ese es el único camino de la victoria. Si no tuvieras fe, no sólo tendrías los mismos problemas o aún mayores, sino que además, muy probablemente, no tendrías la fuerza que da Dios, el consuelo que viene de Dios, para enfrentarte a ellos. Por eso tenemos que considerar que la fe es una suerte. Y debemos cuidar esa fe, para que no se apague ni se vuelva tibia. Cualquier cosa antes que perderla. Para ello, nada mejor que la oración, pues rezar es estar en contacto con Dios, el origen y fin de nuestra fe. Si tienes dudas de fe, no te devanes la cabeza buscando argumentos, reza más, comulga más, acércate al Señor más.

Propósito: Sé consciente de lo bendecido que eres por tener fe y cuida ese don, evitando ponerte en situaciones que la hagan peligrar. Reza más y pídele al Señor que te aumente la fe.

GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING THE EUCHARIST

You are not to eat or drink anything except for water or required medicine, for one hour before actually receiving communion. This is called the Communion or Eucharist fast. It is meant to help us focus on our Lord and what we are about to receive. Chewing gum, candy, mints, etc. during Mass is therefore inappropriate. Both forms for receiving the host are acceptable, in the palm of one hand with the other hand underneath, or on the extended tongue. Extend your hands palm-side up toward the priest and stand as close to the priest as possible when receiving Communion. Never take the host from the priest. After receiving the Eucharist, you say Amen. Proper reverence and respect is most important, hands should be reverently folded while waiting to receive the Sacrament.

DIRECTRICES PARA RECIBIR LA EUCARISTÍA

No debes comer ni beber nada excepto agua o medicinas necesarias durante una hora antes de recibir la comunión. Esto se llama ayuno de la Comunión o Eucaristía. Esto es para ayudarnos a centrarnos en nuestro Señor y en lo que estamos a punto de recibir. Por tanto, masticar chicle, caramelos, mentas, etc. durante la misa es inapropiado. Ambas formas de recibir la hostia son aceptables, en la palma de una mano con la otra mano debajo, o en la lengua extendida. Extiende las manos con las palmas hacia arriba hacia el sacerdote y quédate lo más cerca posible del sacerdote al recibir la Comunión. Nunca le quites la hostia al sacerdote. Después de recibir la Eucaristía, dices Amén. La reverencia y el respeto adecuados son lo más importante; las manos deben estar cruzadas con reverencia mientras esperan recibir el Sacramento.

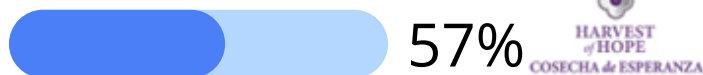

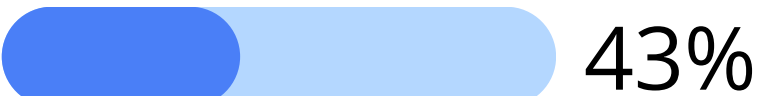

For Catholics and non-Catholics who wish to gain knowledge and information about the Catholic faith. The classes are also for those Catholic adults and high schoolers that have not completed their sacraments. The classes begin in September and will be completed by Easter.

Children's Religious Education

~Faith Formation~ **Registration is online Classes begin August 23rd!**

Saint Stephen provides opportunities for each person to receive the Sacraments and grow in greater communion with our Lord. Classes are for 1st – 8th grades and they meet Sundays at 9a Sept. to May.

Baptism - For a child to be baptized, you must be attending Mass regularly, attend a Baptism class and fill out a registration form. Classes are held the last Sunday of every month at 1pm and must be completed prior to scheduling baptism date. One Godparent must be an active Catholic and attend class as well. A copy of the Child's Birth Certificate is needed at time of registration. Please contact the Office for scheduling.

Matrimony - Arrangements must be made at least 6 months in advance of the proposed date. Participation in a marriage preparation program is required. Couples contemplating marriage **MUST** meet with the priest before setting a date.

Anointing of the Sick - Fr. Estrada is offering Anointing of the Sick at First Friday's Mass at 5:30p.

Active Parishioner Status - Each year we receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings, be godparents or sponsors. An active member is one who is properly registered with the Parish office, regularly gives offertory, attends parish activities when possible and most importantly faithfully attends Mass on Sunday's and Holy days of Obligation. Even though you attend Mass, if you are not registered with the Parish, we have no information about you and you may not eligible to be Sponsors, Godparents, etc. While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination.
