Job Description: Middle School Ministry Director

Reports to: Next Gen Pastor

Classification: Exempt, part-time or full-time (to be determined)

Vision Statement

To see our valley awakened and transformed by the love of God.

Mission Statement

To equip and mobilize people to live the life and mission of Jesus.

Primary Purpose: The role of the Middle School Ministries Director is to provide leadership and oversee the execution of the church's vision, mission, and values through discipleship of students in 5th through 8th grades and their families.

Primary Job Responsibilities:

- Connect with students through life-on-life discipleship by meeting them in their natural environments, such as attending their games, performances, or meeting for coffee.
- Provide spaces on Sunday mornings and midweek where students are equipped to live out the life and mission of Jesus in their relationship with God and with other believers.
- Work with the Middle School Ministry Partner team to create and execute plans and details for the Middle School Ministry, including missional events, camps, and retreats.
- Build a culture of missional living by teaching and modeling people of peace and providing missional opportunities for middle school students.
- Bring energy and fun to gatherings of celebration, sharing of stories, prayer, and worship.
- Work with the Youth Pastor to recruit and train Ministry Partners (MPs) to effectively disciple students, increasing opportunities for further training and development of the MPs' gifts. Build a team culture where MPs are invited into discipling relationships as they disciple students.
- Collaborate with appropriate staff to create a pathway for students to engage with and find ownership of the larger church through knowing our beliefs, engaging in Sunday services, serving, and building relationships with other generations.
- Provide spaces for students to grow in character and competency by learning to hear God and do what he says. These spaces include, but are not limited to, large-group biblical teaching, life groups, various forms of reflection groups, camps, retreats, and mission trips.
- Create opportunities for students to grow as a spiritual family where they support, encourage, and have fun with one another.
- Partner with parents and the families of students by providing shepherding care and encouragement, as well as clear communication.

Additional Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Next Gen Team to develop strategies to carry out the mission and vision for kids and students, ensuring alignment and positive transitions between kids and youth ministry areas.
- Collaborate with the Next Gen Team to create age-and stage-appropriate experiences, as well as opportunities for youth with special needs.
- Implement safety measures related to the youth ministry areas, including MP screening, classroom/building safety, and Next Gen policies and procedures outlined in the handbooks.

- Work with the communications team to create digital and print communications for families and MPs.
- Work with the Youth pastor to steward the annual budget for the Crossroads Youth Ministry.
- Manage documentation for Crossroads Youth Ministry event requests, facility needs, and other paperwork to run day-to-day operations.
- Effectively coordinate tracking of Youth Ministry numbers through the church's health dashboard to ensure the vision becomes a reality.
- Work with the Youth pastor to provide consistent communication opportunities for families through email, newsletters, and Planning Center Group messaging. Post communication, resources, and other content to the middle and high school ministry social media sites.
