For over 50 years, Star Community has helped individuals with disabilities achieve their goals and lead fulfilling lives through services like therapeutic riding and the Stars, Stripes & Heroes initiative.

Looking ahead, we're planning a Veterans Celebration from November 7–11, 2025. More details will be shared in the coming weeks.

Please also join us for our final Crab Feed of the year on Saturday, November 8, 2025. We'll be serving #1 crabs, followed by Karaoke with Eric Piper in the evening.


