Dear Esteemed Members,

The fall season has arrived, and our focal point is on our community. Hagerstown Elks Lodge 378 received a Grand Lodge Beacon Grant of \$4000. Brooke's house located in Hagerstown, MD will receive \$2000 in supplies which we will deliver, these will include comforters, blankets and cleaning/laundry supplies. We will also allocate \$2000 for children in need which will be used to provide personal hygiene supplies along with children's clothing, and footwear.

We are also working with Star Community, located in the Hagerstown area, to secure an additional Grand Lodge Grant. This funding would support the installation of a new water source for their Equine Center and provide supplies for their specialized programs. For over 50 years, Star Community has helped individuals with disabilities achieve their goals and lead fulfilling lives through services like therapeutic riding and the Stars, Stripes & Heroes initiative.

Looking ahead, we're planning a Veterans Celebration from November 7–11, 2025. More details will be shared in the coming weeks.

Please also join us for our final Crab Feed of the year on Saturday, November 8, 2025. We'll be serving #1 crabs, followed by Karaoke with Eric Piper in the evening.

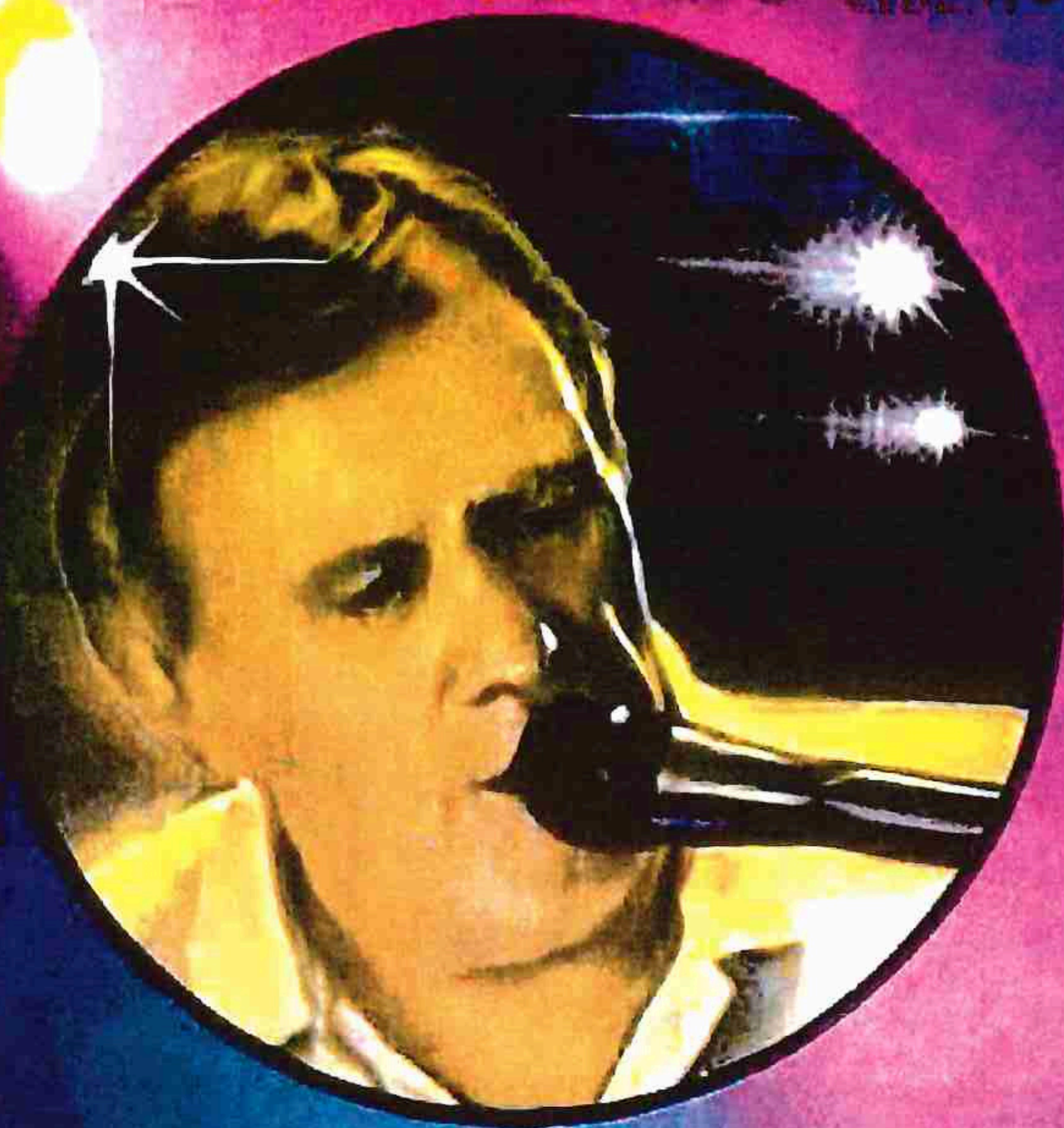

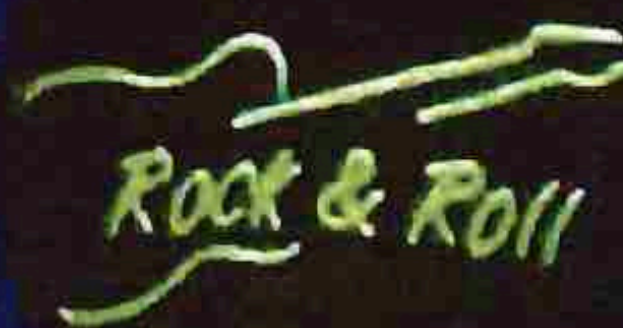
