The Lodge hosted The Community Free Clinic Potter's Bowl on November 9. They used our Banquet Hall and Kitchen facilities. We also donated \$1,000 to the Community Free Clinic from the Bingo Charity Fund.

The Lodge Christmas Food Basket campaign is an opportunity to assist those in our community who could use extra help. If you know a family in need, please be sure to complete their form prior to the cut-off date of December 7. Submission forms will be available for pick-up in the office.

We are again supporting the Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots campaign. Donations will be collected at the Lodge using the drop-off boxes.

The Children's Christmas Party will be held on December 20, and on December 21st we will honor our members with the annual Egg Nogg Party, for members and their spouses/significant others only. 


