Project Access is a physician-led program of the Medical Foundation of Chattanooga. Since its inception in 2004, Project Access has donated health care services to more than 25,600 patients and provided \$232 million in donated healthcare services.



VIM's primary care clinic has provided over 82,000 patient visits valued at more than \$29 million at clinic rates and \$114 million at conservative ER rates; and \$20 million in patient prescription assistance and \$6 Million in donated labs since opening the doors in 2005
