### The Ark of Love (an excerpt)

It was a rainy day in August 2014 when I started as an AMA Volunteer. After a few days of orientation at the welcoming community of Madrangca, San Jose, Antique, we were sent to different mission areas. I'm a teacher by profession. I joined AMA because I wanted to share my knowledge and experiences, and AMA's ministry is in line with my career. I thought everything was perfect: a teacher's license right after graduation as well as teaching experience in Sta. Rita Academy-Assumption Antique. I was confident that Ms. Gamay Solis, the AMA Coordinator, would assign me to an Assumption school here in the Philippines but I ended up in a place for which I was not prepared L'Arche Philippines/Arko ng Pilipinas Inc., a community in Cainta, Rizal that takes care of persons with intellectual and mental disabilities.

I struggled for months in the mission area. In my past teaching experience, I was the leader of my students but in L'Arche they were my teachers. I did not expect much from them, and I learned to accept myself and to value the present moment. I became a Special Education teacher for basic reading, writing, and arithmetic to special children every morning and a Workshop Coordinator in the afternoon. We made bead crafts and cards made of grass.

At night, I slept in the room of Raymond, who kept shouting. In the morning, I assisted him in taking a bath using the language of silence. There were times when I felt I was really tired but I just looked at them and saw that they were happy to see me, so I never stopped loving and caring for them.

They even surprised me on my birthday! Ate Lala and Ate Rea brought a cake in front of me, saying "bawal ang umiyak" ("no crying"). I made a wish and blew the candle. JP and Benito sang in front of me while Mariflor gave a card. Life is full of surprises, indeed! They really taught me how to love and that I should love first in order to be patient. I thank God so much for bringing me to L'Arche Community. In those moments of my life, I discovered my talents and abilities such as dancing, writing poems, and organizing activities. Most of all, it led me to a path where I learned to be near Jesus.

Finally, when people ask me if the L'Arche community learned so much from me, my answer is the reverse: the assistants, volunteers, and children taught me a lot. St. Marie Eugenie of Jesus, foundress of the Religious of the Assumption, reminds me that with love I can do great things: "The world is too small for my love". -SME
