After graduating from high school, I continued to teach and dance recreationally while attending cosmetology school. After earning my license, I began working behind the chair at Society Strands as a co-stylist.

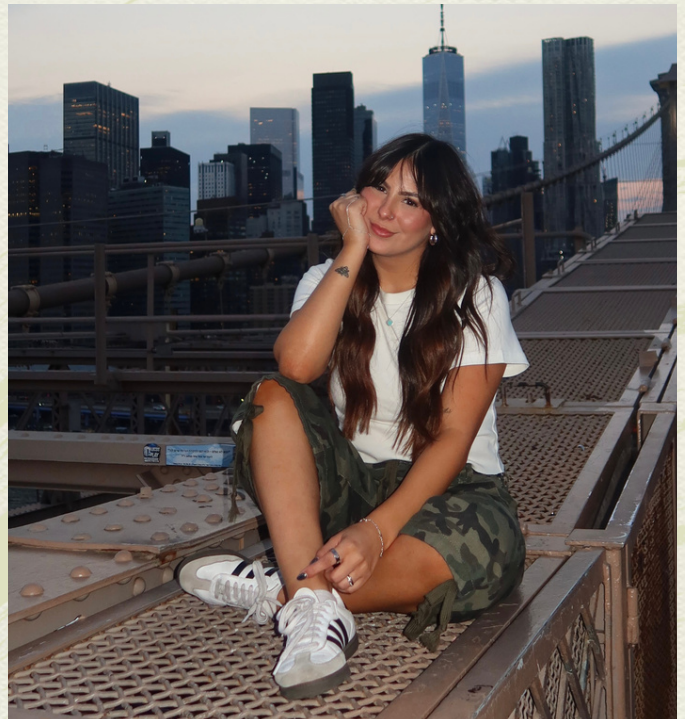

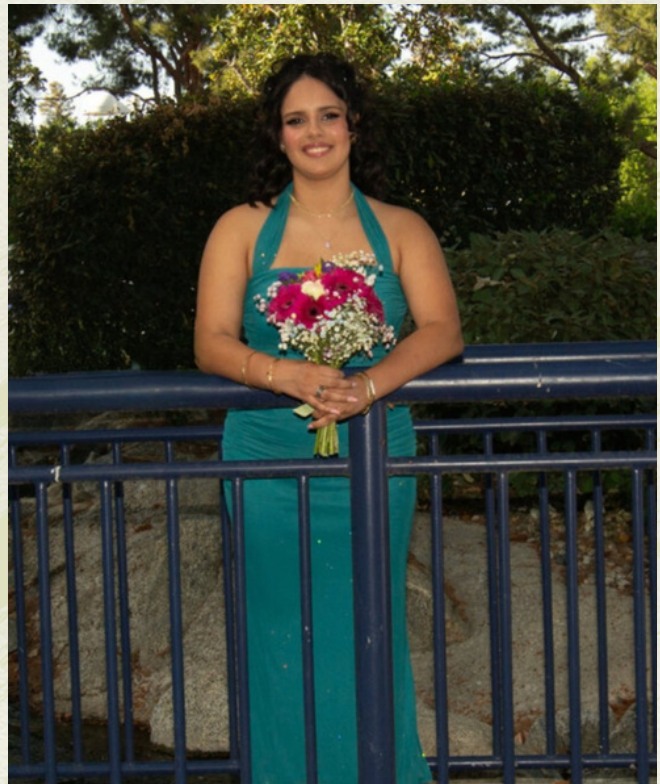
