Tryouts

On tryout day please have your athlete wear all black with their hair in a high ponytail. They must wear cheer shoes. Please no glitter outfits.

On the last day of clinics your athlete will get a paper with their tryout time and date.

Parents must wait in the lobby during tryouts but curtains will be closed.

Team placement emails will be sent out in waves on Sunday May 24th. You must accept your team placement by responding to that email within an hour.

Once you accept team placement you will get an email with your athletes practice schedule and the day to come in for team signed day. On this day you will return your signed packet and your commitment fee will be ran electronically on this day.

Team signing day will consist of parents turning in all paperwork and athletes meeting their team and coaches.

Parent/Athlete contract

Making a team on Ground Zero Athletics is a huge honor and not to be taken lightly. I understand that being placed on a team is entering a contract. I agree to the following and will uphold the rules of the handbook and code of conduct.

- If an athlete is removed from a team due to breaking GZA rules the remaining yearly balance will be due and charged with the card on file.
- If an athlete quits a team position the remaining yearly balance will be due and will be charged to the card on file.
- Coaches reserve the right to move up an athlete due to improvements, as well the right to move down an athlete due regression and or lack of effort.
- Coaches reserve the right to make an athlete sit out of a competition if there are any safety concerns with stunting, tumbling or transitions.
- Coaches reserves the right to remove an athlete from the team for any bullying or ongoing behavior issues without improvement with no refunds. If this occurs the remaining yearly balance will be due and charged with the card on file.
- Coaches reserve the right to remove an athlete due to ongoing attendance issues with no refunds. If this occurs the remaining yearly balance will be due and charged with the card on file.
- If you are leaving another program and coming to GZA all outstanding fees must be paid to the previous program. You must have left this program on good terms.
- If you are coming in mid season you must have a letter of release from the former gym and all fees paid.
- If my athlete makes a team, I understand all Choreography dates are mandatory and will plan accordingly.
- I have received the Parent/Athlete handbook and will abide by it fully.
- I understand that end of season events are mandatory and must stay in designated hotel set by gym.

Agreement made on this date, between *Ground Zero Athletics LLC*, a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the state of Ohio, with its principal office located at 1166 Kauffman Ave, as a Physical Fitness Center referred to herein as the **Gym**, and the undersigned adult responsible for paying for the minor child. The minor child is hereinafter called **Client**.

Whereas Client desires to join an All Star Team at the **Gym** and cannot join a team without an adult responsible for the child agreeing to the rules and regulations set forth below and abiding by the terms of this Agreement;

Whereas, the Gym provides physical training services designed to prepare the Client of competition. All services are intended to improve the health and performance of Client;

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained in this agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Tuition, Additional Fees, Term, Cancellation, and Holds

All Team options are listed below. Tuition and Additional Fees must be paid for in advance. All tuition, fees, and schedules are subject to change without notice. Pricing and dollar amounts for each competition season are outlined as TBD and will be released at a later date and I agree to pay these additional fees without refund. By signing this Agreement, the adult responsible for the child is agreeing to that pricing under these payment terms.

Term: The adult signing this Agreement understands that upon signing this Agreement, they are not entitled to any refund or credit of any part of the membership dues unless otherwise provided for in this Agreement or by Law.

Cancellation: This Agreement may not be canceled Unless written notice given by owners.

2. Automatic Payment Authorization Through Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

The adult responsible for the child represents and warrants that if they are purchasing something or paying for a service from this Gym that (i) any credit card, debit card, or bank account draft (ACH Draft) information Client supplies is true and complete, (ii) charges incurred by Client will be honored by the adult responsible for the child's credit card company or financial institution, and (iii) the adult responsible for the child will pay the charges incurred by Client at the posted prices, including any applicable taxes, fees, and penalties.

The adult responsible for the child hereby authorizes (if online payment is made or autopay information is provided) this Gym to charge their ACH draft, credit card, or debit card account for the following amounts: (1) Client's recurring membership dues, and (2) any other fee for other goods/services Gym provides that the adult responsible for the child instructs Gym to bill to Client's account on file. There is a \$5.00 fee for credit card processing and will be added to your monthly statement.

GZA Athlete and Parent Code of Conduct

Welcome to the Ground Zero Athletics (GZA) Program!

We are pleased to welcome you to the GZA program, an organization dedicated to excellence in competitive cheerleading. Our definition of excellence extends beyond the outcome of competitions; it encompasses effort, teamwork, commitment, and sportsmanship. These principles serve as the foundation of our program, and we are excited to have you and your athlete join our growing gym family.

Acknowledgment and Responsibilities of Parents/Guardians

This document is provided to you as the parent or legal guardian of an athlete who has chosen to participate in the GZA program. Your child's involvement in cheerleading presents valuable opportunities for personal, athletic, and academic growth.

By allowing your child to participate in our program, you acknowledge and accept the responsibilities and obligations set forth in this Code of Conduct. Your acknowledgment along with that of your athlete, affirms your commitment to upholding these responsibilities and cooperating with GZA personnel in enforcing this Code. Compliance with the Athletic Code of Conduct is mandatory and a condition of participation in the GZA program.

GZA is committed to providing:

1. A safe and well-maintained training environment, including appropriate equipment and facilities;
2. Experienced and qualified coaching staff;
3. Competitive opportunities that adhere to industry standards, including certified officials and fair competition;
4. Support for athletes, coaches, and parents to foster a positive and productive athletic experience.

All parents, guardians, and spectators are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. Any behavior deemed inappropriate or unsportsmanlike may result in removal from events and/or restrictions on future attendance.

We recognize the vital role that athletics plays in a child's development, both as a participant and as a member of the broader community. We look forward to working with you and supporting your child's journey in competitive cheerleading.

Athlete Code of Conduct

As a member of the GZA cheerleading team, each athlete is held to a high standard of excellence. By joining the team, athletes agree to adhere to the following expectations and conduct requirements:

1. **Respect and Professionalism:** Athletes must be respectful toward all gym staff, coaches, teammates, and parents at all times.
2. **Appropriate Language:** The use of vulgar, profane, or inappropriate language is strictly prohibited in any setting.
3. **Personal Appearance:** Athletes are expected to maintain a well-groomed appearance. Attire for community events and competitions shall be determined by the coaching staff.
4. **Behavioral Expectations:** Athletes must exhibit appropriate behavior at all times, both inside and outside the gym. This includes adherence to all program rules during training sessions, competitions, and team activities.
5. **Zero Tolerance for Bullying:** Bullying, in any form, will not be tolerated. This includes verbal, physical, and cyberbullying.

6. **Social Media Conduct:** Athletes are required to maintain appropriate behavior on social media. Any form of unsportsmanlike conduct—including posts that disparage the team, another team, or an individual teammate—will result in disciplinary action, up to and including removal from the program. Athletes will refrain from posting content that is explicit or could be perceived as inappropriate in any manner.
7. **Drug and Alcohol:** All athletes are required to be free of all illegal substances. Athletes are prohibited from posting any photos of them holding drinks in cups of any kind while under an athlete contract with our brand. This pertains to ALL social media accounts.
8. **Personal Nutrition:** Athletes will fuel their bodies properly to ensure strong and healthy bodies and minds. We reserve the right to bench your athlete if a nutrition issue arises until proper steps are taken by all adults to get the athlete back on track.
9. **Grades:** While we are not an affiliate of any school districts, we still prioritize your athletes' schooling. If grades start to slip we may take action under parental guidance.
10. **Safety & Awareness:** Athletes are responsible for acting in a safe manner at all times while at the gym, community activities or any other event involving athletes presence. This also pertains to routine awareness and floor awareness in the gym as well as knowing the routine counts.

Failure to comply with the Athlete Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to warnings, suspension from activities, or dismissal from the program at the discretion of GZA ownership.

GZA Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent or legal guardian of an athlete participating in the Ground Zero Athletics (GZA) Program, you play a vital role in fostering a positive, supportive, and respectful environment for your child, their teammates, coaches, and the broader GZA community. Your conduct directly influences the experience and success of your athlete and the team. Therefore, all parents and guardians are expected to adhere to the following Code of Conduct.

Parental Responsibilities and Expectations

By enrolling your child in the GZA cheerleading program, you acknowledge and agree to:

- 1. Support and Encourage Positive Conduct**
 - Promote sportsmanship, teamwork, and respect for all athletes, coaches, staff, and fellow parents.
 - Refrain from engaging in or encouraging any form of verbal abuse, physical confrontation, or negative behavior toward athletes, coaches, judges, officials, or other parents.
- 2. Respect Coaching Decisions and Team Policies**
 - Acknowledge that coaching decisions regarding team placement, choreography, practice schedules, and competition participation are made in the best interest of the team.
 - Avoid interfering with coaching decisions or attempting to influence the selection of athletes for routines, positions, or roles.
 - Address any concerns or grievances professionally through the appropriate channels, following GZA's communication protocol.
- 3. Demonstrate Good Sportsmanship**
 - Exhibit respect and courtesy at all practices, competitions, and events, both in person and online.
 - Avoid engaging in negative discussions or gossip about athletes, coaches, judges, or other teams.
 - Recognize and respect the efforts and achievements of all participants, regardless of the competition outcome.
- 4. Compliance with Competition and Gym Rules**
 - Ensure timely attendance and commitment to the team's practice and competition schedules.
 - Follow all facility rules, including designated areas for parents and spectators.
 - Comply with all regulations set forth by competition governing bodies and event organizers.
- 5. Social Media and Digital Conduct**
 - Refrain from posting negative, defamatory, or inappropriate comments about the GZA program, its athletes, coaches, staff, or competitors on social media.
 - Ensure that any online content related to GZA upholds the integrity and reputation of the organization.
 - Report any instances of cyberbullying, online harassment, or inappropriate digital behavior involving GZA athletes or families.
- 6. Zero Tolerance for Disruptive Behavior**
 - Any form of harassment, intimidation, or bullying toward athletes, parents, coaches, or staff will not be tolerated.
 - Any behavior deemed inappropriate or disruptive may result in disciplinary action, including removal from events, suspension from attending practices, or permanent dismissal from the program.
- 7. Zero Tolerance for Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco**

- Your athlete is required to be free of all illegal substances. It is your responsibility as their guardian to ensure they maintain this. Athletes are also prohibited from posting photos while holding cups of any kind on ALL social media.
- Ground Zero facility is a tobacco free campus. This goes for directly in front of our building as well. This pertains to all smokeless tobacco as well as vapes, e-cigs etc.

8. Nutrition

- Athletes are expected to maintain a healthy diet. This sport requires healthy bodies and minds. Your child's nutrition is key to their success. If we notice a change in their physique we will have a meeting to determine the reasons. If it becomes an ongoing issue, we will work together to get your athlete back on track.

9. Medical

- If your athlete requires medication, or inhalers it is your responsibility to ensure they have what they need for practices and competitions. We can not administer medication without consent.

Acknowledgment of Code of Conduct and Consequences for Violations

Failure to comply with this **Parent Code of Conduct** may result in disciplinary measures based on nature of incident, including but not limited to:

- **Verbal or written warnings** from GZA staff or management.
- **Temporary or permanent restrictions** on attending practices, competitions, or other events.
- **Suspension or expulsion** of the athlete from the GZA program due to the parent's noncompliance with the Code of Conduct.
