A Few Words From Fr. Dariusz.....



This weekend all over the world Catholic celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, known as Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to “Body of Christ.”

The Catholic Church gathers throughout the whole world to celebrate the great

mystery of the Eucharist. Of course, the Church does this every time the Mass is celebrated, but on this Sunday, we are asked to pause and take special notice of the great gift that has been left to us by Christ. Today in a special way, we give thanks for the gift of the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus’ suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist.

The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others.”

This Solemnity is given to us as a yearly reminder of the Awesome Gift we celebrate that is the Eucharist. The Mass that we attend is more than a simple reminder or remembrance. Our faith teaches us that at Mass we are mystically connected with Christ’s sacrifice and with the presence of the Risen Christ. This solemnity reminds us to respect this Gift, to reverence this Gift.

When we come into Church, we genuflect to pay respect to the Divine Presence and to remind us that we are before the Lord. When we are about to receive communion, we stop and reflect on what it is that we are about to do. The reception of communion is sacred. This is the time to focus on what we are about to do. Just before receiving communion, we bow. That is a statement of faith, just as saying Amen is a statement of faith. We are taking Jesus within ourselves. After receiving communion, we pray to the Lord of the Universe within us. The Eucharistic Presence fills us and sustains us. We take this presence within us every time we receive communion.

That is what it means to be a Catholic. We are people of the Body and Blood of the Lord. That is exactly what the disciples said to Jesus at the conclusion of the Great Discourse on the Eucharist in the sixth chapter of John’s gospel, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. For my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink.

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord reminds us of who we are, Who is present in the tabernacles of our churches, and what we are doing when we receive communion. May this sacred time nourish us with his abundant love and renew our relationship with him.

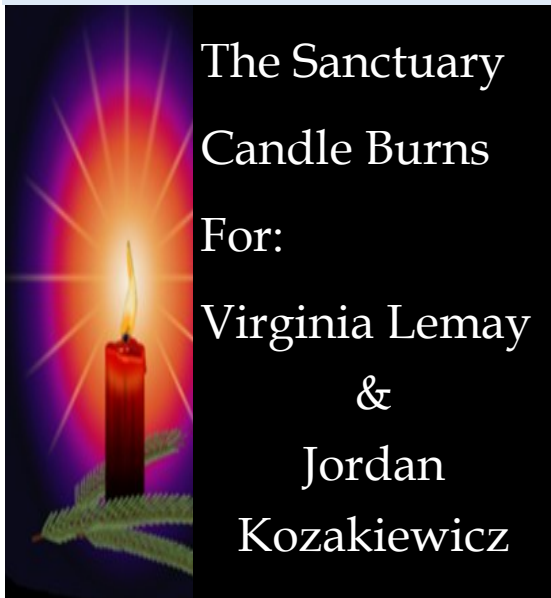
