A Few Words From Fr. Dariusz.....



St. Anne

Before the Blessed Virgin Mary, there was Anne of Nazareth, a woman adored by God and filled with God's Grace. Anne was chosen by God to be the mother of Our Lady and maternal grandmother of Jesus Christ.

However, the names of the Blessed Virgin Mary's parents are never given in the scriptures. Her origins are the thing of legend. Their inspiring story of unwavering faith, prayer, and perseverance is beautifully detailed in the ancient, non-canonical text known as the Protevangelium of James (or the Gospel of James) According to tradition, Joachim and Anne were a deeply devout, wealthy couple living in Nazareth. Despite their piety, they were childless into their later years, which was viewed as a public disgrace and a sign of divine disfavor in their culture. One day, while Joachim was at the Temple of Jerusalem to make an offering, a priest publicly rebuked him and refused his gift because he had not produced a child. Overcome with grief and humiliation, Joachim did not return home. Instead, he retreated into the mountains and the desert, fasting and praying for forty days.

Back home, Anne mourned both the absence of her husband and her continued barrenness. In her deep distress, she wept and made a solemn vow to God: if she were granted a child, she would dedicate it to the service of the Lord.

Her prayers were miraculously answered. An angel appeared to Anne, telling her that God had heard her pleas and that she would conceive a child who would be spoken of throughout the world. Around the same time, the angel appeared to Joachim in the wilderness, bearing the same joyful news.

Following this, the couple joyfully reunited at the **Golden Gate** of Jerusalem. Anne eventually gave birth to a daughter whom she named **Mary**. Honoring the vow she had made to God, the couple nurtured Mary's pure spirit, and when she was just three years old, they brought her to the Temple of Jerusalem to be raised and educated.

Because of their patience and ultimate triumph over suffering, Saints Anne and Joachim are celebrated today as the patron saints of grandparents and married couples. Their feast day is celebrated on July 26.

Barren and childless for a long time, Anne remained faithful and hopeful. With eyes up and heart open, she fervently prayed for a child with her equally devout husband Joachim. The godly couple's faith was beautiful and unbreakable. Their way of life pleased and moved God. In response to Anne's patience and purity, God granted her prayers and blessed her with a daughter like no other: the Mother of God. God loved Anne so much that He did the impossible and made conception at an old age possible. To receive the Mother of God in Anne's womb was a blessed gift and special grace. Mary was definitely worth the wait! By being docile, Anne was able to be an instrument of God, and her docility made space in her womb for God's Love to bear fruit. Saint Anne had the ability to carry life and cooperate with God. Because of her maternal love and receptivity to God, Saint Anne was able to raise Mary with grace. She generated a life of purity in Mary by educating her with God's wisdom. Mary's womb was blessed just like her own mother's. Mary, thereby, inherited her mother's capacity to receive another and ultimately God. Saint Anne is significant because by giving of herself, she blessed the world with Our Lady and Queen Mother who gave birth to Jesus Christ Our Savior. I hope you enjoyed the story of St. Ann. May St. Ann pray for us to her Grandson Jesus Christ.
