### *Breakfast Baskets*

If you ordered a breakfast basket prior to your stay it will be delivered to your tent between 8:30-9am. Please note that Breakfast Baskets must be purchased in advance.

### *Quiet hours*

Many of our guests come to Whispering Springs to escape the hustle and bustle of city life and enjoy a little peace and quiet in the great outdoors. For this reason, we have implemented 'quiet time' beginning every evening at 11pm. We kindly ask all our guests to be mindful of fellow glampers during your stay at the Springs.

### *Poison Ivy*

Poison ivy is native to Northumberland County, so please be aware and conscious of this potent little plant. For those who have never encountered poison ivy before, just remember "leaves of three, let it be." Poison ivy tends to grow in ditches, so please be sure to stay on the path.

### *Heat*

All our tents are outfitted with electric blankets and electric heaters to help take the chill off those cold nights and chilly mornings.

### *Campfire*

For your safety and the safety of fellow glampers and local wildlife, all campfires must remain in the enclosed firepits provided or the designated campfires located throughout the grounds. Please do not leave your campfire unattended at any point and please ensure that your campfire is out completely before leaving the vicinity or going to bed. Extra firewood can be requested at The Watering Hole.

### *Green Initiatives*

All the water at Whispering Springs flows from a natural underground water source and is some of the purest water you'll ever find - so drink up! At the Springs, one of our goals is to be as green and eco-friendly as possible. To help reduce our environmental footprint, each tent uses an on-demand hot water system with a built in timer. For this reason, it may take a few minutes for your water to heat up. Also, please be conscientious of the fact that we are on a country septic system, and do not flush anything down the toilet except toilet paper.

### *Wildlife*



There are critters out and about in this part of the countryside, so please take care to properly store and dispose of your food. We suggest storing open or leftover food either in the mini-fridge in your tent or in your car. Please do not feed the wildlife as human food is often not the best for their little tummies.
