




# From Our Pastoral Staff



## Seven Last Words of Christ - A Lenten Retreat Women's Retreat 2026 - Registration Due March 1

When someone we love is at the point of death, that person's last words are often the most important lessons that he or she teaches us. The Seven Last Words of Christ are seven distinct sayings Jesus spoke from the cross, offering profound messages of forgiveness, salvation, love, abandonment, distress, triumph, and trust. These phrases are traditionally drawn from the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John) and used for Lenten reflection. This retreat will examine these final phrases uttered by Jesus on the Cross and serve to help participants focus on the order and structure of these words, showing how Jesus called on God as Father at the beginning and at the end of His Crucifixion. Through discussion and reflection, the retreat will help to encourage us to turn to our Heavenly Father in times of suffering and challenge. Following Our Lord's example, we are then able to entrust our heavenly Father with everything and hand over our spirits to Him in abandonment and love.

Our weekend away will be a quiet place to shut away for a few days and spend time in fellowship with other women and with God focusing on elements of the Benedictine tradition. It will be one of prayer, connection, and nourishment of faith as we are encouraged to take some time out of our busy lives to slow down, take a breath and let our minds and hearts focus on the words of Jesus and the implications for our lives.

The cost of \$245 covers overnight accommodation, meals, and use of the facility as well as the retreat materials and activities. 

Thank you to parishioners Mike Wendt and Phil Breunig for helping us remove the damaged Bradford Callery Pear tree on the South end of campus. Heavy snow and ice around December 5-10 caused a large section of the tree to fall. Inspection showed a large crack between the two halves of the tree, which is unrepairable by other means. The tree was very unbalanced, and another large storm would most likely take down another large limb. It was recommended to remove the tree completely and plant a new species that is less prone to storm damage. We are grateful to our parishioners lending their time and talent!

You can reserve a Mass intention by visiting or calling the Parish Office. Intentions are reserved on a first come, first served basis.




## Lenten Collects For Local Non-Profits
