The parables of Jesus are located mainly within the three synoptic gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke and their importance can hardly be overestimated. They are generally regarded by scholars as among the sayings which we can confidently ascribe to as the authentic words of the historical Jesus and reflect the great themes of Jesus' preaching. Perhaps no part of the Gospels, then, can better put us into touch with the mind of Jesus than the parables and still today, present us with the challenge with which Jesus encountered his hearers in first-century Palestine.
