 - Some teams may play 2 games in an evening in a pool or round robin style tournament
 - One game break between games if playing 2 games in an evening

 - Saturday and Sunday - 4:30, 5:30, 6:30, 7:30PM
 - Times may be adjusted slightly to accommodate team scheduling conflicts

 - 2nd, 3rd, and Consolation winner medals will be awarded in 8-team tournaments
