Delta Breeze is proposing an equipment rental program to provide affordable access to gear, generate funds for equipment replacement, and teach participant accountability.

Program Purpose

- Provide affordable access to quality lacrosse equipment for new and returning players.
- Generate additional revenue to help repair, replace, and expand the club's equipment inventory.
- Promote accountability by encouraging players and families to properly care for club-owned equipment.
- Reduce financial barriers so more athletes have the opportunity to play lacrosse.

Benefits to the Club

- Creates a dedicated funding source for future equipment purchases.
- Makes participation more affordable for new families.
- Encourages accountability and proper care of club-owned equipment.

- Supports the long-term sustainability of the Equipment Rental Program.

Proposed Rental Structure

- Used equipment rental: \$50 per season.
- New equipment rental: \$150 per season.
- Equipment is issued before the season and returned at the conclusion of the season.
- Rental fees are reinvested into maintaining, replacing, and expanding club equipment.

Next Steps

- Finalize rental pricing and program guidelines.
- Present the Equipment Rental Program for Board approval at the July Board Meeting.
- Develop the equipment checkout and return process.
- Launch the program following Board approval.

Player Equipment Provided

Girls: Goggles or helmet (if available), stick, and mouth guard.
Boys: Helmet, stick, neck brace, gloves, elbow pads, and chest protector.
