Financial Assistance Program

Program Purpose

Delta Breeze Lacrosse Club believes every child should have the opportunity to participate regardless of financial circumstances. Financial assistance is awarded based on demonstrated need, available Club funding, and qualified applications.

Assistance Available

- 25%, 50%, or up to 75% of registration fees.
- Registration fees only (does not include uniforms, USA Lacrosse membership, equipment, tournaments, travel, or optional activities).

Application Requirements

- Completed Financial Assistance Application.
- Two forms of income verification (Federal Tax Return, two current pay stubs, unemployment statements, or disability statements).
- Letter of explanation for extraordinary hardships (hospitalization, job loss, death in the family, etc.).

Review Process

- Applications reviewed confidentially by the President, Vice President, and Treasurer.
- Evaluated on household income, family size, financial need, hardship, and available Club funds.

Recipient Responsibilities

- Complete 8 volunteer hours each season.
- Remain in good standing with Delta Breeze Lacrosse Club.
- Volunteer hours may be completed by any adult family member.

Funding Guidelines

- Application deadline: January 10.
- Awards are subject to available funding and are not guaranteed.
- First-qualified, first-served while funding remains.
- Families must reapply each season if assistance is needed, generally not to exceed two consecutive seasons without exceptional circumstances.

Community Scholarship Initiative

Delta Breeze Lacrosse Club is actively pursuing partnerships with local businesses and community sponsors to establish a dedicated scholarship fund. Our goal is to secure sponsorships that will fund financial assistance awards and expand opportunities for families in need.
