Malaysia Flight MH128 diverted to Alice Springs Airports due to technical issues

Airport Development Group (ADG) confirms that Malaysia Flight MH128, from Melbourne to Kuala Lumpur, was diverted to Alice Springs Airport today due to technical issues.

In collaboration with the airline and relevant services, ADG swiftly activated its response procedures, ensuring the safety of all passengers and crew. The aircraft landed without incident, and passengers were disembarked and managed in line with domestic flight protocols.

The team at Alice Springs Airport worked efficiently to rebook the majority of passengers on domestic flights for today. A smaller number of passengers will stay overnight in Alice Springs, with onward domestic flights arranged for tomorrow.
