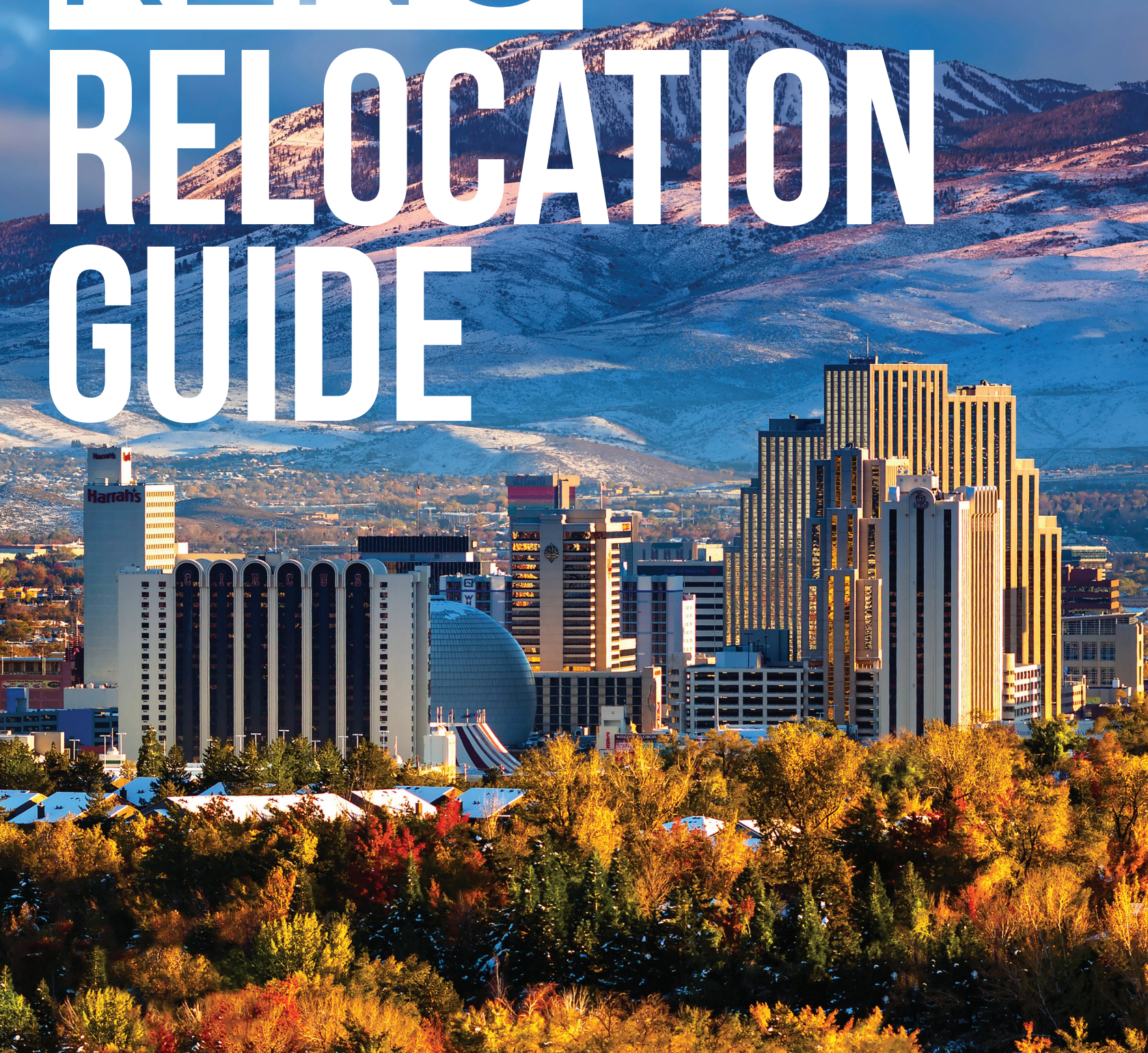

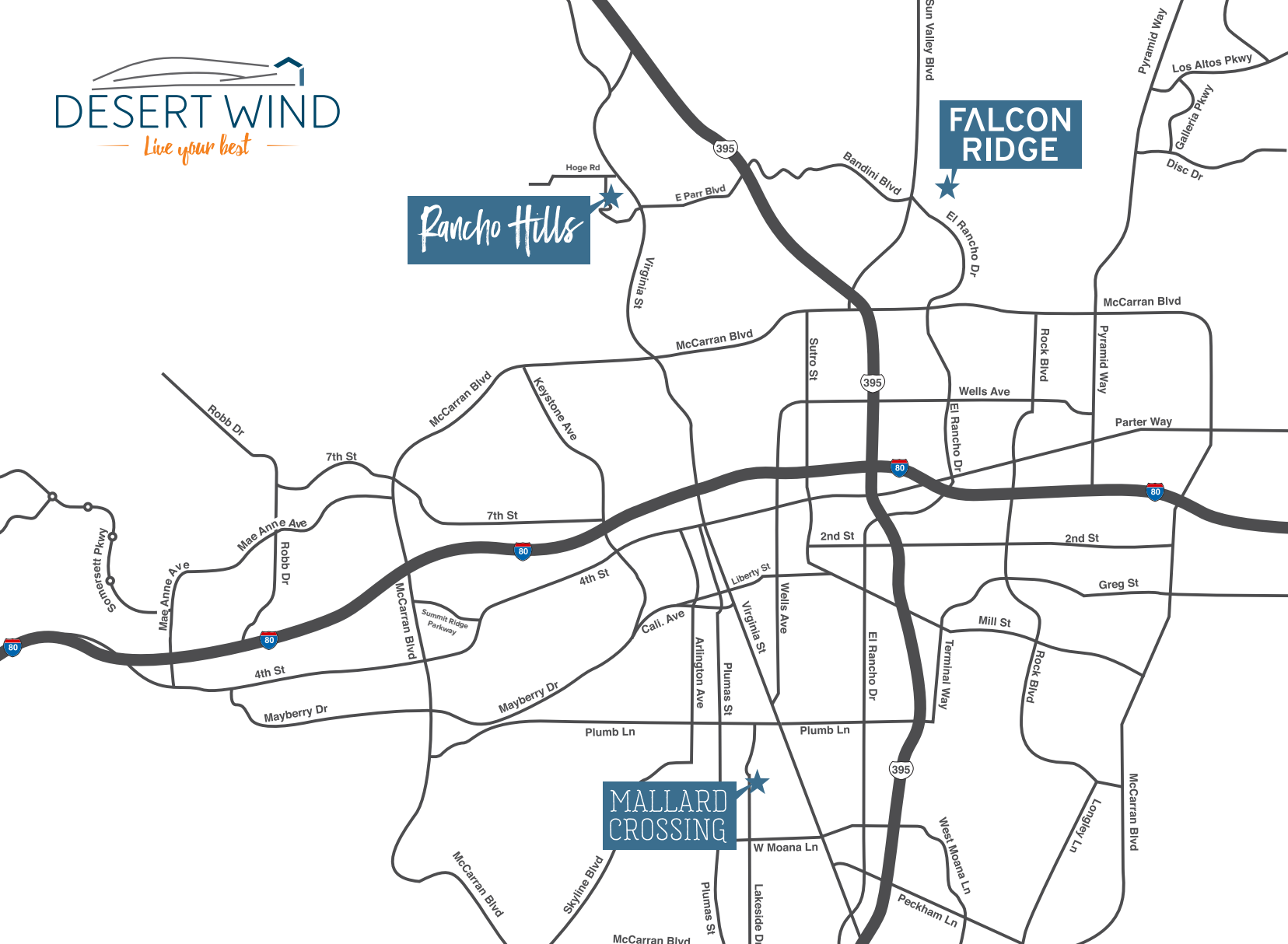

ABOUT NEVADA

Nevada State History

European explorers traveled through Nevada in the early 19th century, but it was not until 1851 that the first settlements were established. An Act of Congress created the Territory of Nevada on March 2, 1861. James W. Nye of New York was appointed Nevada’s first Territorial Governor by President Abraham Lincoln later that year. On October 31, 1864, President Lincoln proclaimed Nevada’s admission to the Union as the 36th state. The State’s first elected Governor, Henry Blasdel, took office on December 5, 1864.

After Nevada’s acceptance as a state in 1864, the state has seen great success. For many years Nevada has been above much of the United States in jobs, growth, and new industry. Much of Nevada’s success has been due to various economical advantages such as mining, gaming, and military. From 1960-1980 Nevada was the fastest growing state in the US with a growth rate of 70% in 1960, 64% in 1970, and 14% in the first half of 1980. In an attempt to attract new businesses, particularly in the high-tech industry, the state promoted such features as its absence of state, corporate, or personal income taxes, inexpensive real estate, low wages, and its ready access by air or land to California. The last known population of Nevada, taken in 2014, was recorded at 2.8 million.

Reno Climate

Reno sits approximately 4,400 feet above sea level. Sitting in the driest state in the nation, Reno receives 7 inches of rain and approximately 23 inches of snow each year. With an average of 252 sunny days, Reno residents experience four distinct seasons. Winter lows in the twenties with occasional snowfall. Summer highs are in the nineties with a dry heat and occasional rainfall. The comfort index is 75 out of 100, where the high the number the more comfortable. The US average comfort level is 44.

Registering Your Vehicle

If You're New to Nevada

New Nevada residents, excluding military personnel and students, must obtain their driver license and vehicle registration within 30 days of moving to Nevada, or before the prior registration expires, whichever comes first. Failure to do so will result in a \$1,000 fine.

Documents needed to register are the ORIGINALS of:

- Most recent registration
- Out of State Plates
- Nevada emissions control certificate (smog check)
- Nevada Proof of Insurance
- Nevada Vehicle Inspection Certificate (VIN Check)
- Certificate of Title if ownership is changing. If not changing ownership, the owner has the option of retaining the out-of-state title.

Insurance Information

Nevada law requires drivers to carry vehicle insurance that is written by a state-licensed insurance agent. The minimum coverage requirements are:

- \$15,000 bodily injury, \$30,000 /person /accident, and \$10,000 property damage.
- It is mandatory that a proof of insurance card be kept in your vehicle at all times.

Change of Address

If you are already a resident, Nevada law requires motorists to notify DMV of a change of address within 30 days of moving. Keeping your address current is important so the DMV can send renewal notices in the mail. You can easily do this online at www.DMVnv.com.

Voting Information

Nevada is a closed primary state, which means voters cannot vote for partisan offices in the primary election unless they are either registered with the Democratic or Republican parties.

You must be at least 18 years old by the election date and have lived in Nevada and Washoe County for at least 30 days prior to the next election in order to vote.

Applications are available at post offices, libraries, DMV locations, various other sites, and online at www.nvsos.gov. Applications may be completed and returned either in person, through the mail, or submitted online.

RTC RIDE is the public transit bus system of the greater Reno/Sparks area, providing residents and visitors with safe and reliable bus service. They are committed to making your trip a pleasant one. They're proud of their clean, modern bus fleet and their professional and courteous coach operators.

RTC RIDE service began on Sept. 17, 1978 with five used buses serving four routes. Today, the system encompasses the cities of Reno and Sparks, and areas of Washoe County using a fleet of 70 buses on 26 routes. The service area has grown to approximately 136 square miles. Last year, 8.4 million rides were taken on RTC transit services.

RTC SIERRA SPIRIT...Pause at any of Sierra Spirit's 32 convenient stops, and in less than 10 minutes, a bright yellow SIERRA SPIRIT bus will arrive. The SIERRA SPIRIT route takes you from Reno to the University of Nevada, all around downtown, and back. The electric bus on the SIERRA SPIRIT route operates every day of the year including all holidays. The electric buses offer free WiFi so you can tell your social media followers about this great service to the game! Buses come every 15 to 20 minutes, and the fare is 25 cents or 10 cents for those qualifying for a reduced rate.

WCSD also offers high school students choices for innovating, rigorous and stimulating curriculum through

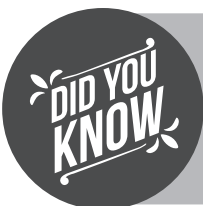

Accountability Reports

As part of educational reform in Washoe County schools, the School District now provide Accountability Reports. The report furnished each spring to parents include statistics about a school's performance as well as achievements, highlights, awards, goals and technology use. Age Requirements

Nevada law requires school attendance between ages 7 and 17. Kindergarten is part of the regular school program. A child must be five years old on or before September 30 to attend kindergarten and must be six years old on or before September 30 to enter first grade. State law requires that a child must attend a state-approved kindergarten program or take a developmental assessment test to enter first grade.

Enrollment

In order to enroll students:

- Must have proof of immunizations before classes begin
- Parents entering their children in a District School for the first time must have identification, child's social security number, and two forms of proof of address. Proof of child's identity can be the original birth certificate or passport. Identification must be an original—no copies are accepted. The required proof of address can be a recent utility bill, rent receipt, residence lease or sales contract. Telephone bills, cable bills, and driver's license are not accepted as proof of address.
- All students who are transferring from another school district require transcripts or report cards from the previous school.

Immunizations

Nevada law requires that children in kindergarten through grade 12 are current with their immunizations before they are allowed to enter school. Parents/guardians are to bring immunization records with them to school when they register their child. A child will not be allowed to attend school without documentation of immunizations. Exceptions are permitted for "religious objections," which requires a letter from the parent or guardian stating the religious objection, or for a medical condition, which requires a letter from a health care provider.

Immunizations are offered by the Washoe County Health District for the following: DPT (diphtheria, whooping cough and tetanus), MMR (measles, mumps and rubella), polio, hepatitis A, hepatitis B, Tdap, and varicella (chicken pox). An administrative fee of \$15 per visit is charged. Students new to Nevada are required to have immunizations for hepatitis A and B, and varicella (chicken pox). Students who have had chickenpox will be exempt from the requirement for Varicella immunizations.

For the classes of 2017 and 2018, students must take four End of Course (EOC) Examinations, take the College and Career Readiness Assessment (ACT), and must have earned a minimum of 16 credits in required courses (below) and 6.5 credits in elective courses for a total of at least 22.5 credits.

For the class of 2019 and later, students must pass four End of Course (EOC) Examinations, take the College and Career Readiness Assessment (ACT), and must have earned a minimum of 16 credits in required courses (below) and 6.5 credits in elective courses for a total of at least 22.5 credits.

- English – 4 Credits
- Math – 3 Credits
- Science – 2 Credits
- Physical Education – 2 Credits
- World History U.S. History – 1 Credit
- Government – 1 Credit
- Art/Humanities – 1 Credit
- Health – 0.5 Credit
- Computer Literacy – 0.5 Credit
- Electives – 6.5 Credits

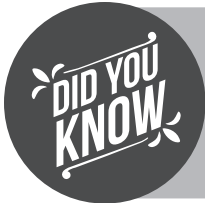

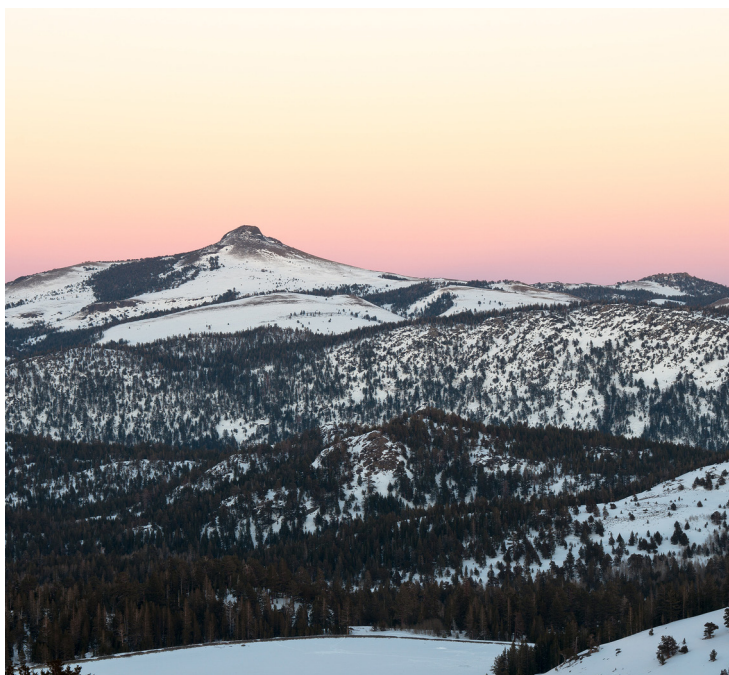
