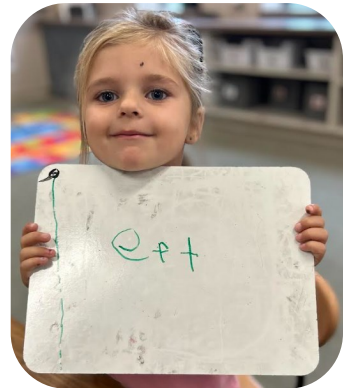

## 2nd Grade

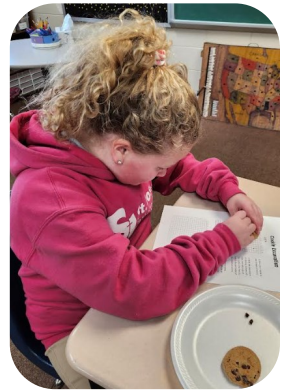
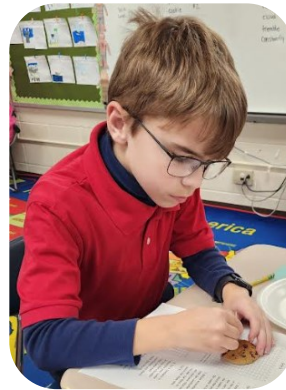
Second Graders and their families attended a retreat together on Saturday to help prepare to receive the Sacrament of First Reconciliation later this school year!

Field trip to the Open Door Café at St. John the Evangelist Cathedral.



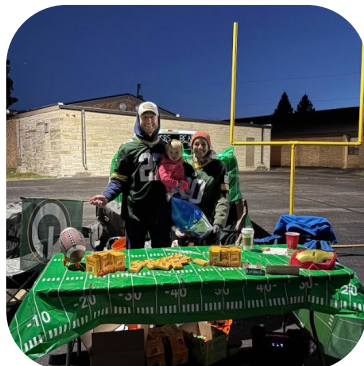






# Trunk 'N Treat

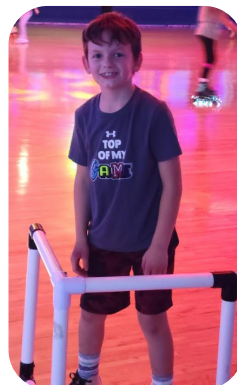
