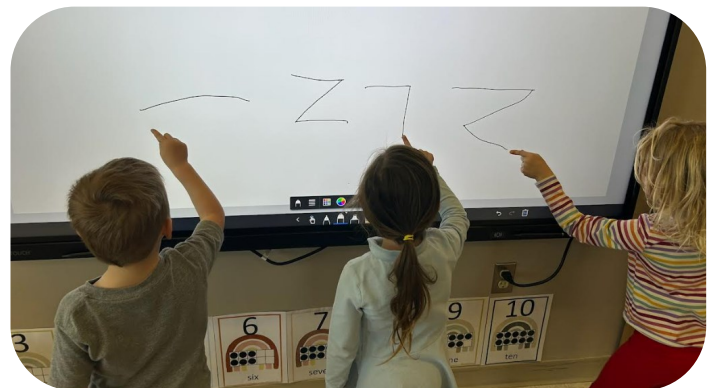


Cleverboards

Practicing their Letter of the Week, "Z".

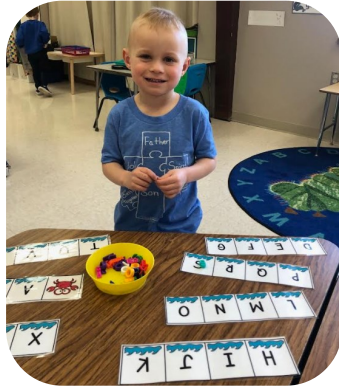
3K

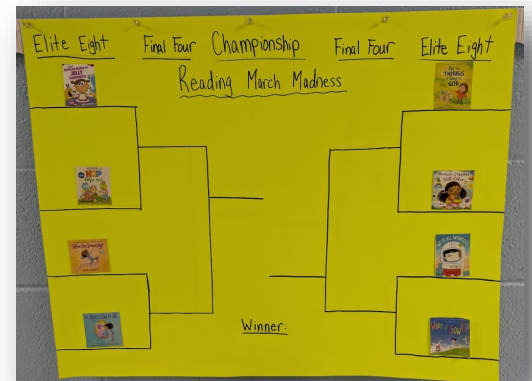

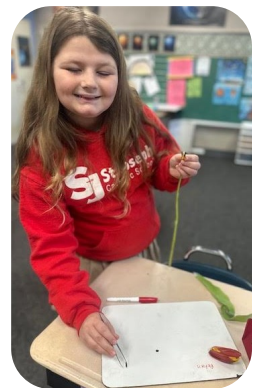

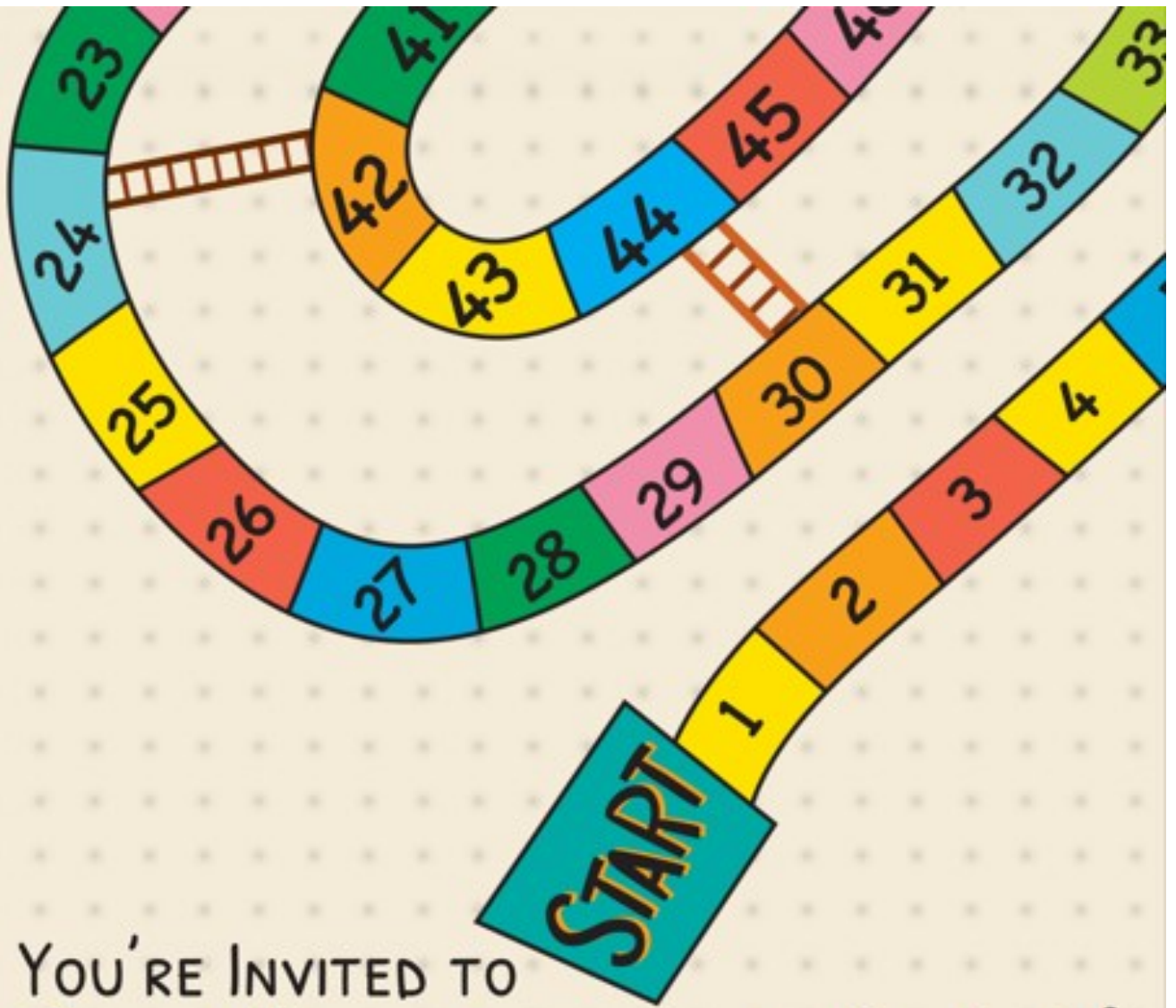
