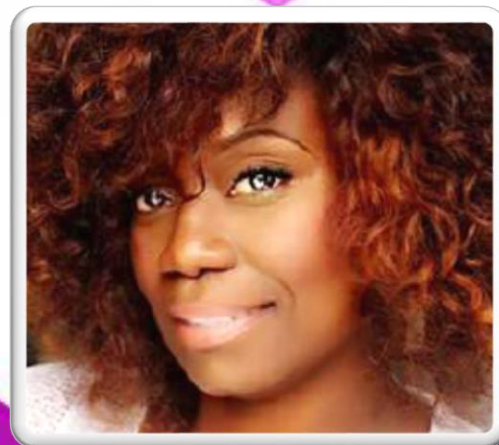

The Personality with a Purpose

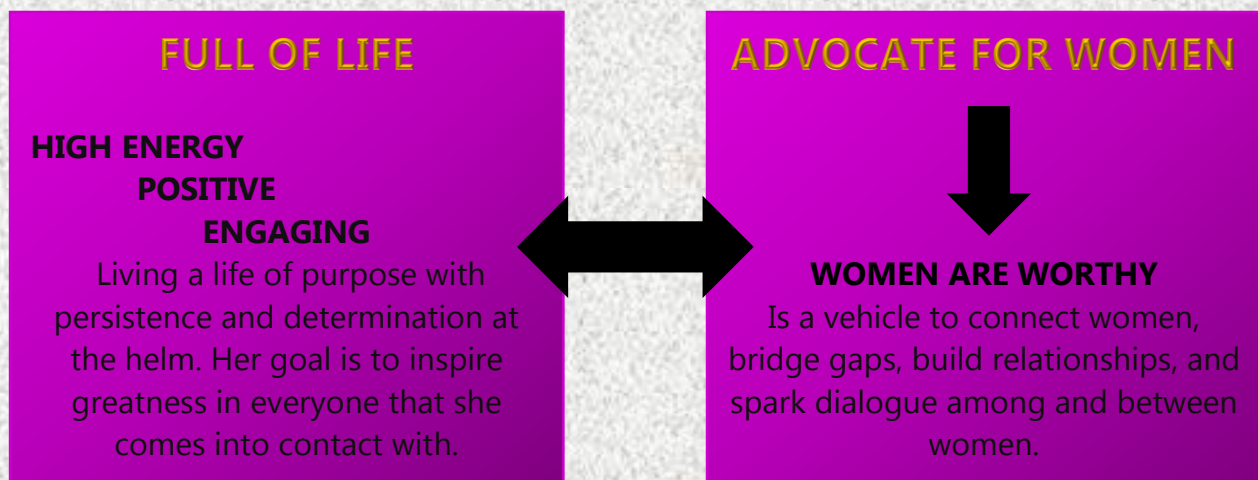
