As the Authorizing Agent(s), I (We) hereby agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Funeral Home of Record and Family Cremation Services, its officers, agents and employees, of and from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, and suits of every kind, nature and description, in law or equity, including any legal fees, costs and expenses of litigation, arising as a result of, based upon or connected with this authorization, including the failure to properly identify the decedents of the human remains transmitted to the crematory, the processing, shipping and final disposition of the cremated remains, the failure to take possession of or make proper arrangements for the final disposition of the cremated remains, claims brought by any other person(s) claiming the right to control the disposition of the decedent or the decedent's cremated remains, or any other action performed by the Funeral Home of Record, its officers, agents, or employees, pursuant to this authorization, excepting only acts of gross negligence.
