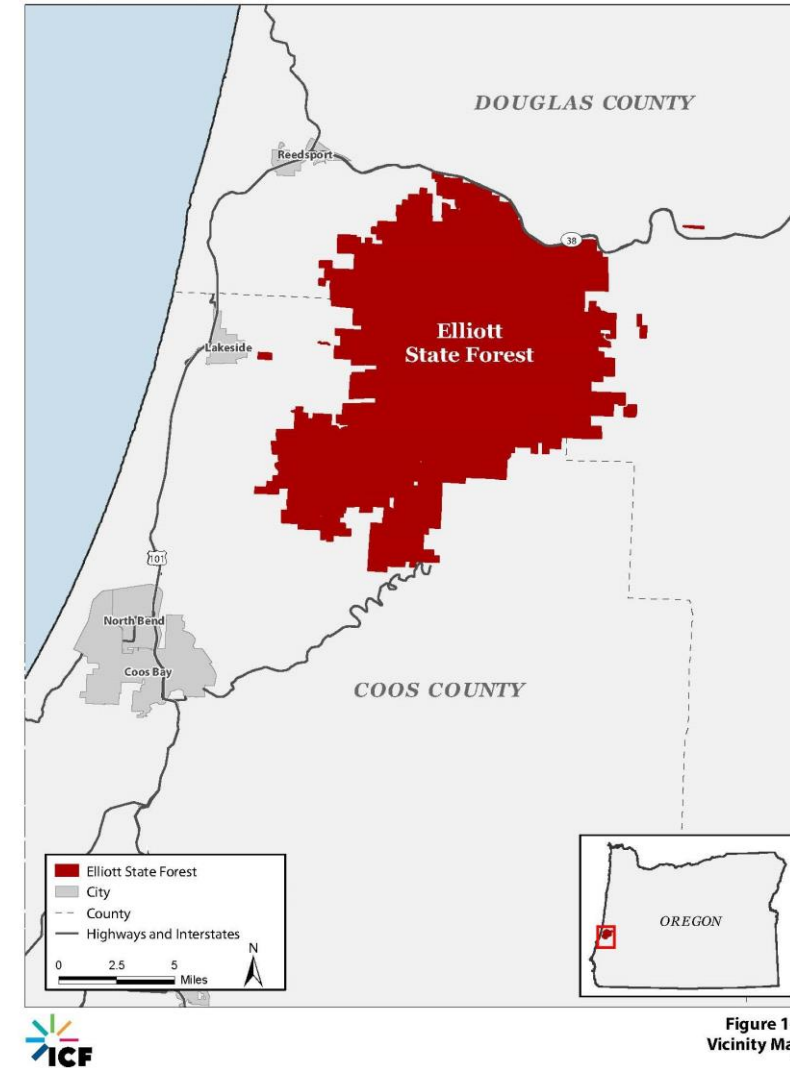

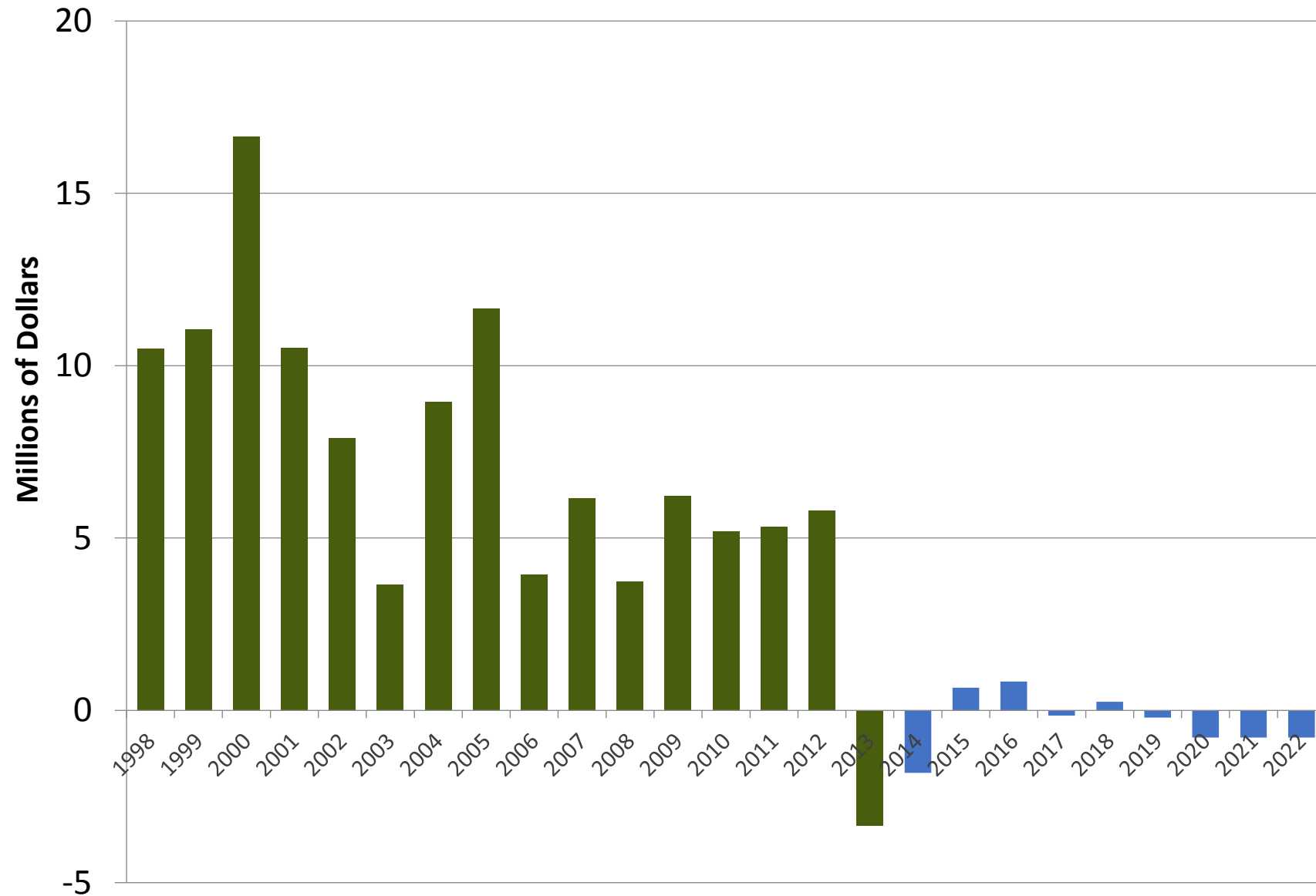


Elliott State Forest

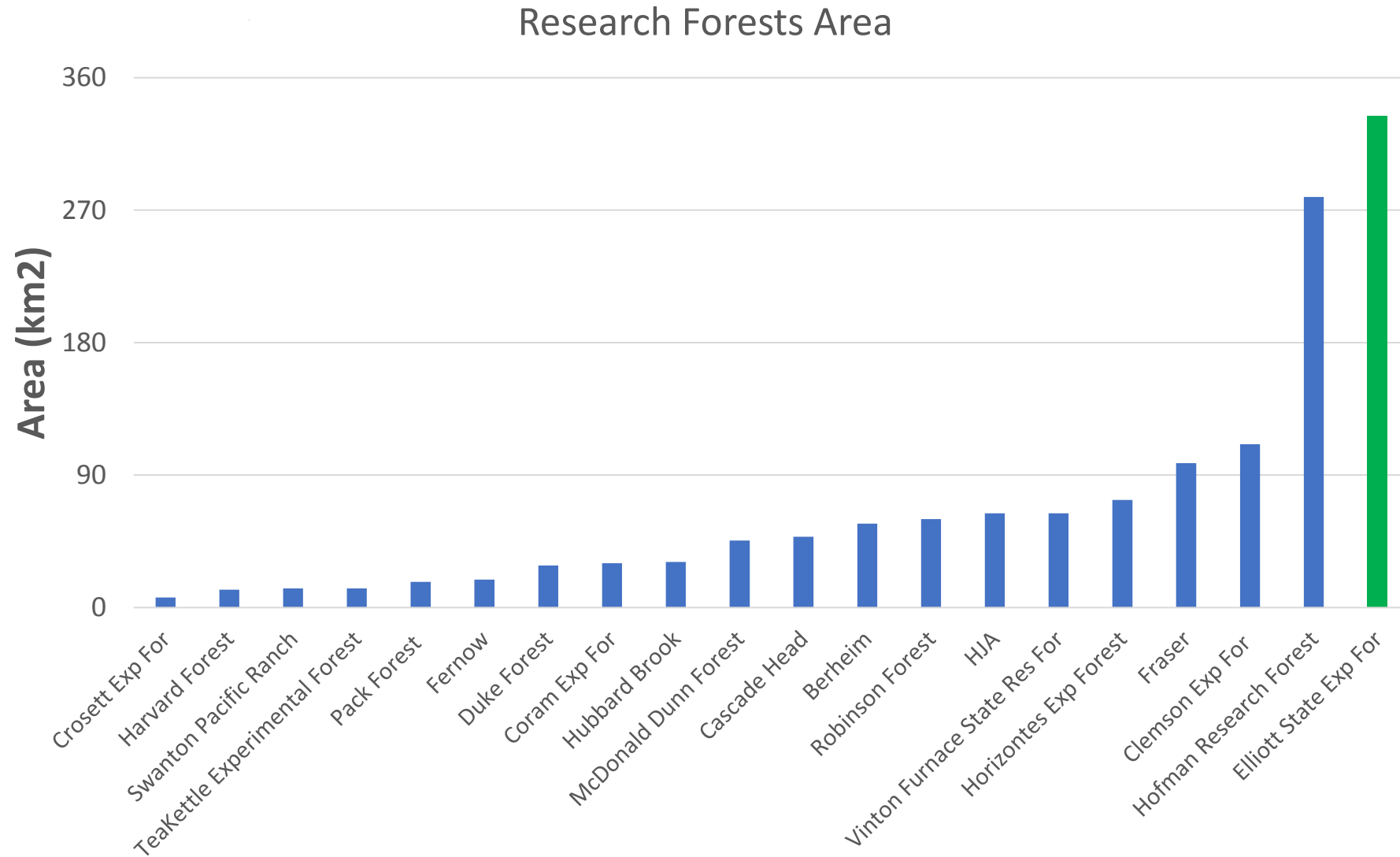
Land Board's Direction

- **Keep the forest in public ownership and ensure public access and recreation opportunities**
- **Decouple the forest from the Common School Fund by compensating the fund for the value of the forest and releasing it from its obligation to generate revenue for schools.**
- **Complete a Habitat Conservation Plan to ensure at-risk species protection and the ability to actively manage the forest to be financially self-supporting.**
- **Manage the forest to provide multiple public benefits including research, recreation, species conservation, active forest management, education, and tribal partnerships**

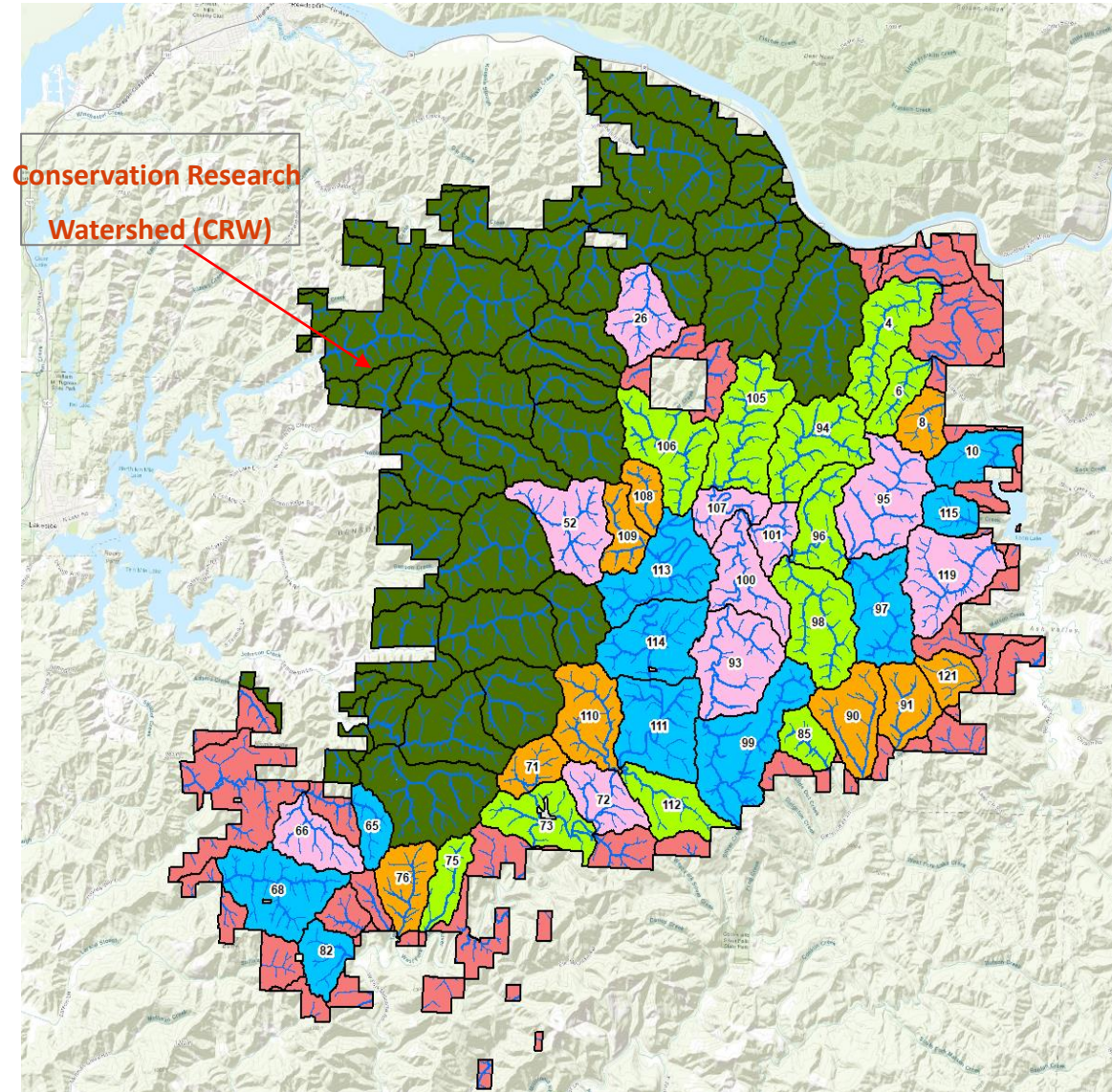


North American Research Forests

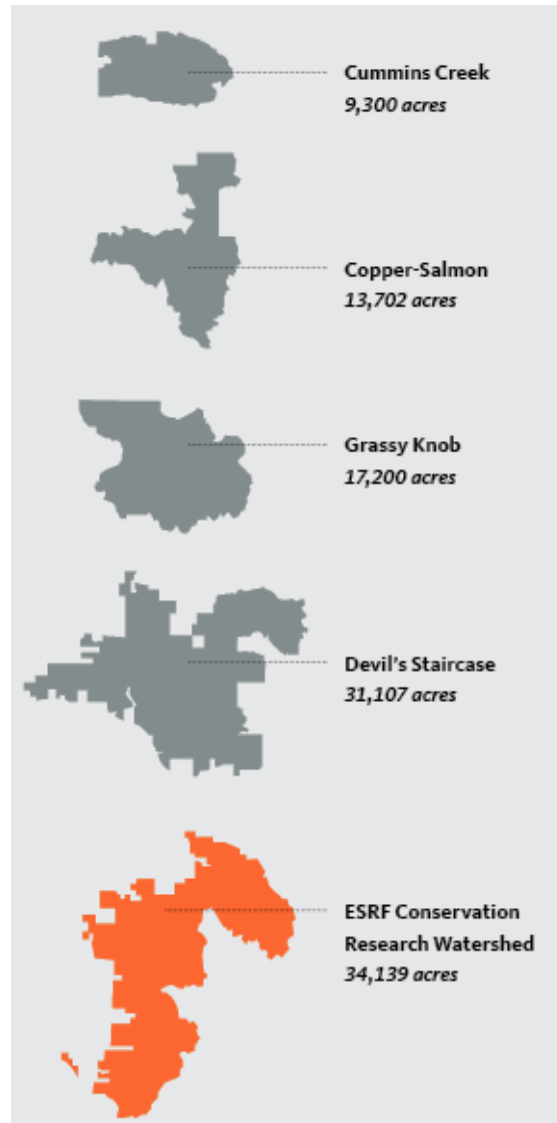


Research Design – “Blocked” Conservation Research Watersheds

- Over 34,000 acre reserve (shown in dark green)
- Manage for “old forest” conditions
- No harvests. Limited thinning of young plantations for conservation purposes
- Grow an older more complex forest over time



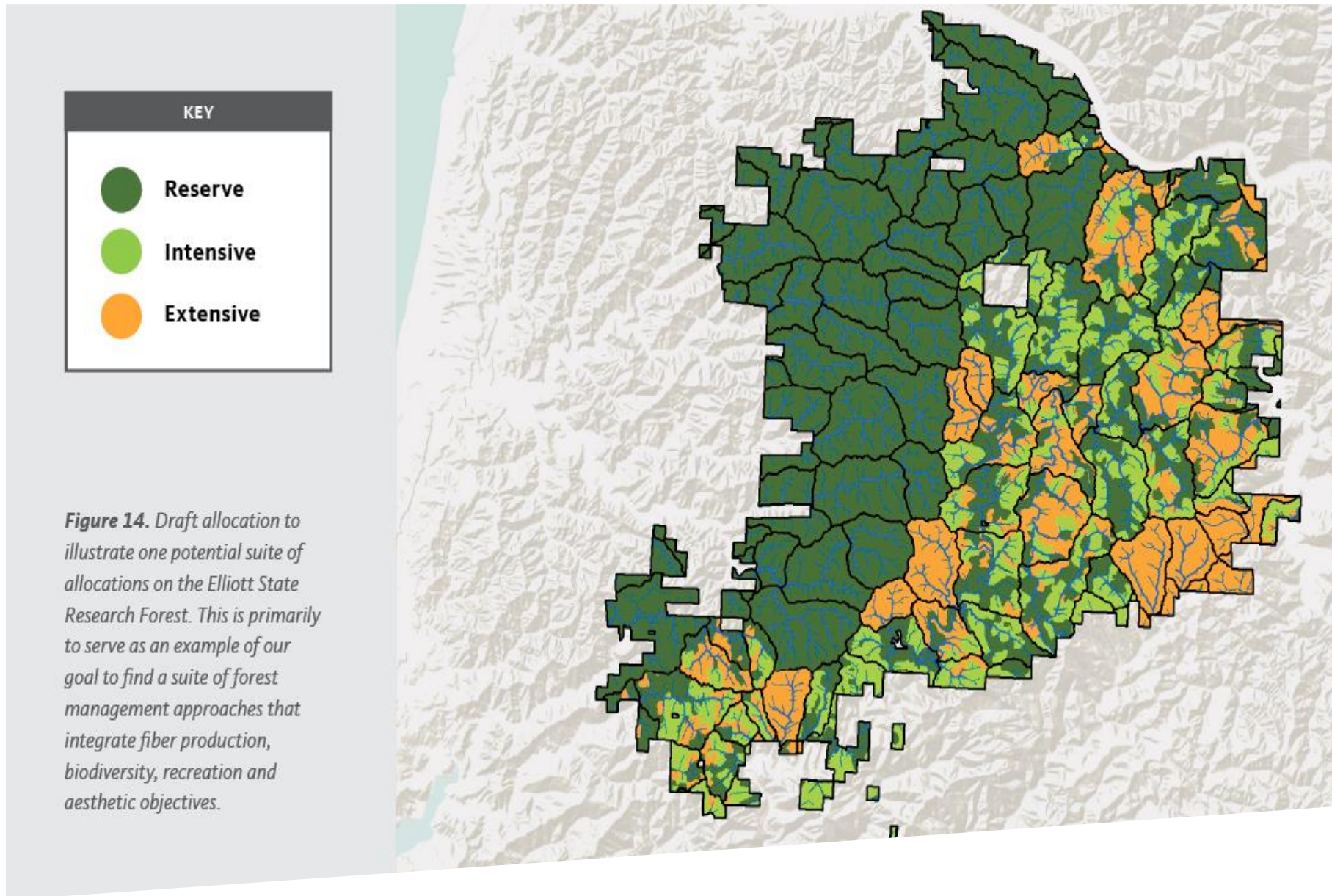
Creation of a New Reserve Network



The Elliott's ~34,000 acre Conservation Research Watershed and the recently established Devil's Staircase Wilderness Area are nearly adjacent and together, would create a ~66,000 acre reserve. The largest in the Oregon Coast Range.

Left: Size of the four largest wilderness areas in the Oregon Coast as compared to the Conservation Research Watershed.

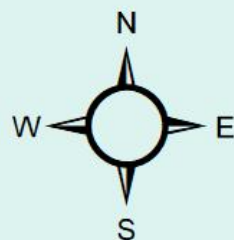

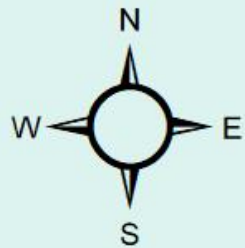

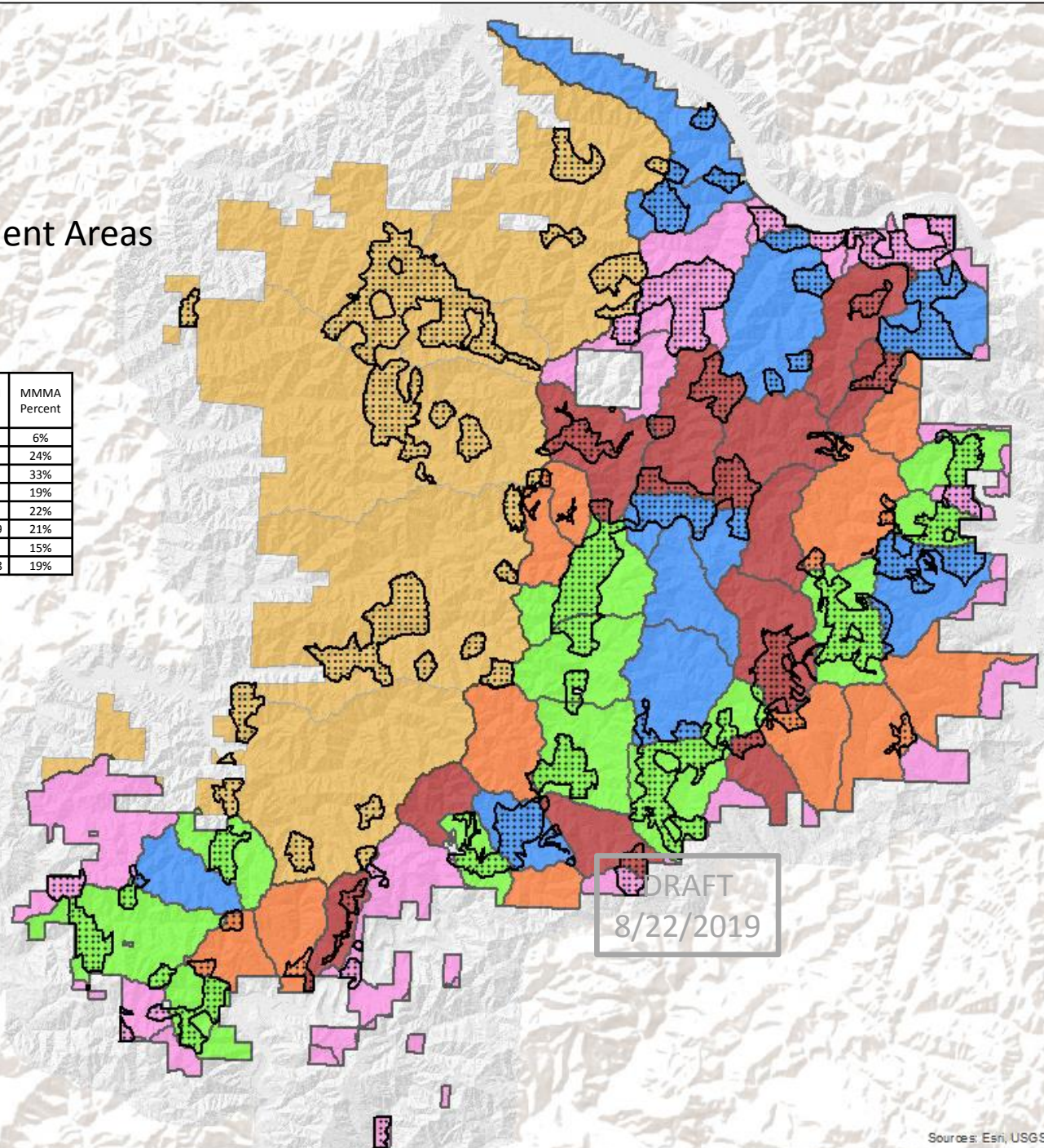
