- All applicable provisions of the Rules for Regulation of Beds, Waters, and Airspace over Navigable Lakes and Streams in the State of Idaho (IDAPA 20.03.04.000 et seq.) are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- Construction will follow details and specifications shown on the approved drawings and data provided by the applicant. Should such information and data prove to be materially false, incomplete and/or inaccurate, this authorization may be modified, suspended, or revoked in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, Idaho Code Title 67, Chapter 52.
- This permit does not convey the State's title to nor jurisdiction or management of lands lying below the natural or ordinary high water mark.
- Acceptance of this permit constitutes permission by the Permittee for representatives of the Department of Lands to come upon Permittee's Property at all reasonable times to inspect the encroachment authorized by this permit.
- The Permittee shall indemnify, defend and save harmless, the state, its officers, agents and employees from and against any liability, claims, damages, losses, debts, obligations, judgments, expenses or actions, including reasonable attorneys' fees from action related to this permit. If it becomes necessary for the State to defend any action seeking to impose any such liability, Permittee agrees to pay the State all costs of court and attorneys' fees incurred by the State in effecting such defense in addition to all other sums that the State may be called upon to pay by reason of the entry of a judgment against it in the litigation in which such is asserted.

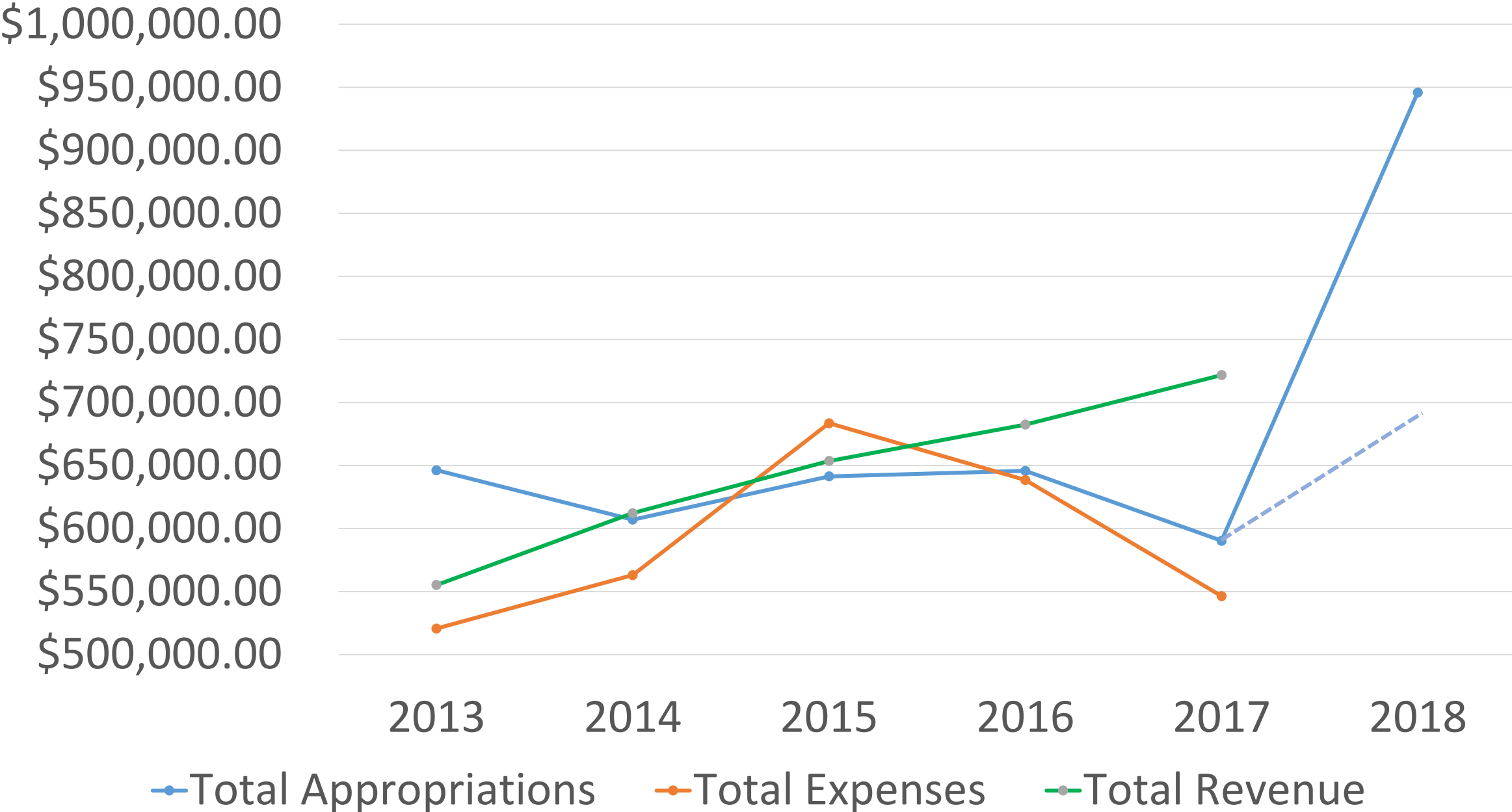

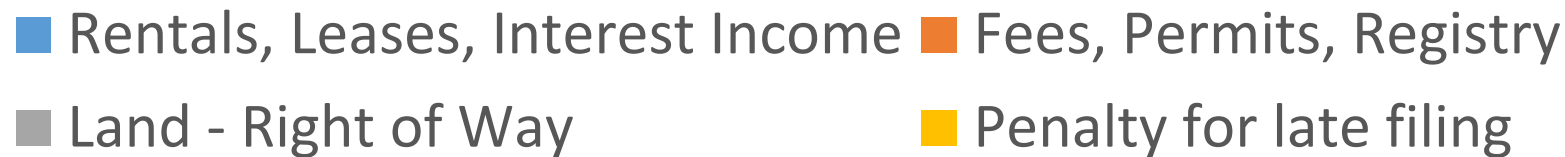

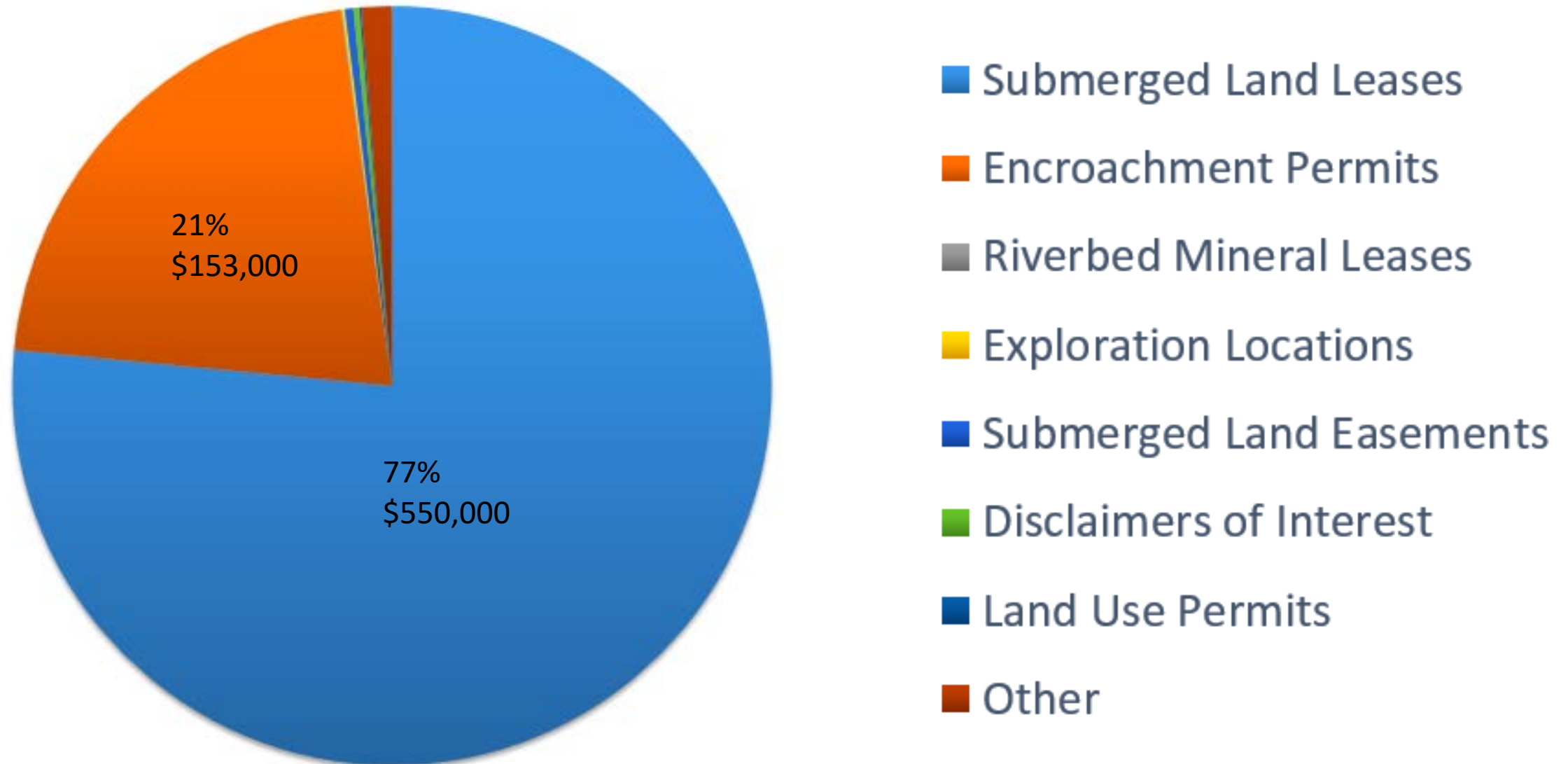
