



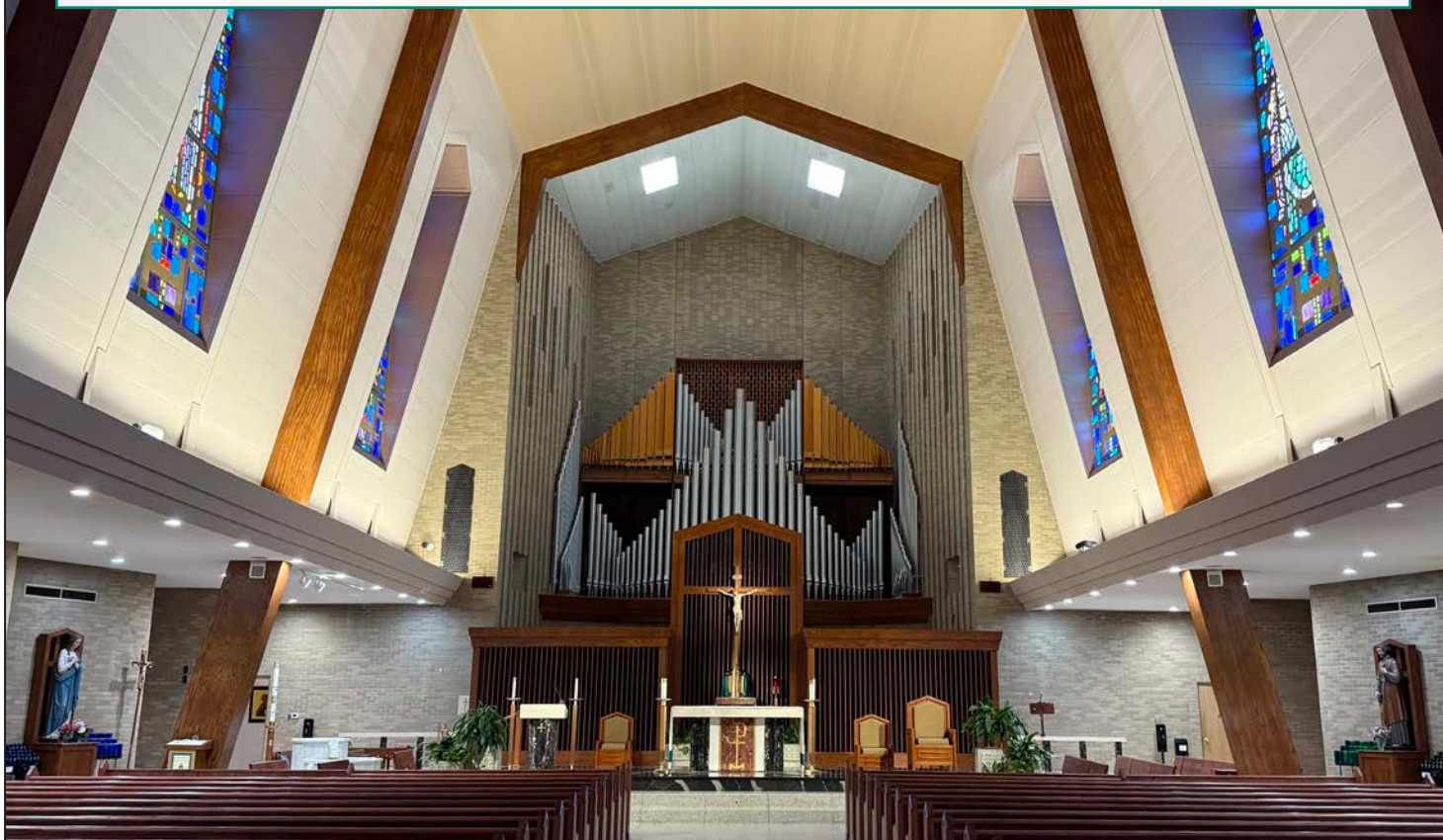

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent *or by appointment*.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at 419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish.
Religious Life: Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. If you are interested in this vocation, you can contact Sister Maria Amata, RSM, at <https://toledodiocese.org/page/delegate-for-consecrated-life#welcome>.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

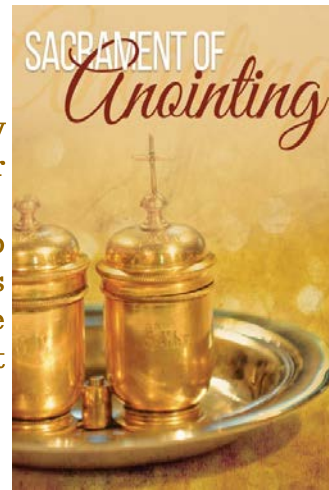
WORSHIP: Worship is the response of the People of God to the Father's invitation to be one with Him, expressed through the Church's official liturgy, as well as through other prayers and devotions. Our worship is direct to the Father, through the Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. All the ministries related to the prayer of the Church are included in this category.



At the 4:30 Mass on Saturday, October 18th, we will celebrate the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This celebration is for those whose health is impaired by physical or mental illness, age or weakened condition, or for those who are about to undergo a medical procedure. Seating will be reserved for those who would like to receive the sacrament, and you will be met at the doors for assistance. A Note About the Notes--Our gathering hymn today, "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name" is widely considered THE Catholic Anthem or the Catholic Alma Mater. Originally written in German, this stately hymn is a paraphrase of the "Te Deum" prayer. The Te Deum prayer can be traced back to the 5th century, just a couple hundred years after the Council of Nicea pronounced our theology of the Trinity. God the Father, Son, and Spirit; Three in One. From first glance, this hymn seems to be a generic spout of praise, but on closer inspection each of the phrases are theological truths that Catholics hold dear. The Te Deum begins with: "You

are God: we praise you; You are God: we acclaim you; You are the eternal Father: all creation worships you. To you all angels, all the powers of heaven, Cherubim and Seraphim, sing in endless praise: Holy, holy, holy, Lord." Let us join the angels and saints in singing praise of our good and holy God!--Libby Saxton--Director of Music Ministries

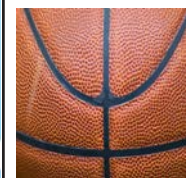

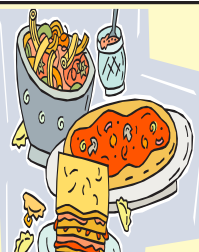

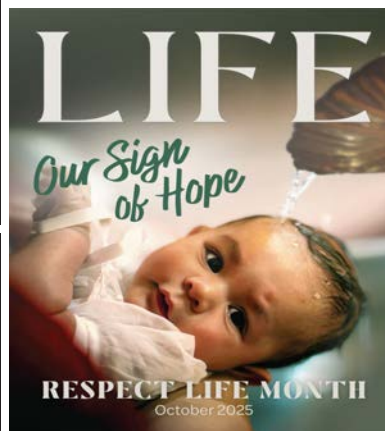

“The saint in sneakers: Carlo Acutis, a teen for our times”

Can you picture a saint wearing tennis shoes, playing video games? Here is our millennial saint who inspires all of us. Carlo Acutis was born on May 3, 1991, in London, England. When he was four months old, his family moved back to Milan, Italy. This is where he spent his short life.

Even as a child, Carlo had a great love for the Holy Eucharist, the Blessed Mother, and the saints. But this love for the Church didn't come from his parents. In fact, his mother, Antonia, had only been to Mass a few times before his birth. By her own admission, her son was the one who encouraged the family to attend Mass. Carlo received his First Communion at age seven, and with love and perseverance, he led his family to a deeper faith even as a child. He went to Mass frequently and Confession weekly. In many ways, Acutis was a normal child and teen. He had friends, attended schools, and was very tech-savvy. He enjoyed playing video games, but he made sure to only play one hour each week. He wanted to keep himself in check and not become addicted.



Carlo Acutis was an ordinary teenager with extraordinary faith. He loved soccer, video games, and spending time with friends. Yet above all, he loved Jesus, especially in the Eucharist. He attended daily Mass, prayed the Rosary, and spent time in Adoration, calling the Eucharist his “highway to heaven.”

A talented computer programmer, Carlo used his skills to build a website documenting Eucharistic miracles, so that others could encounter the living presence of Christ. At age 15, he was diagnosed with leukemia. With great courage and faith, he offered his sufferings for the Pope and for the Church, saying, “I’m happy to die, because I lived my life without wasting even a minute on things that don’t please God.”

Carlo died on October 12, 2006, and was beatified in Assisi in 2020, canonized on September 7th, 2025. His life reminds us that holiness is not far away, but can be lived during our everyday lives.

Carlo had a deep love for the Most Holy Eucharist, saying, “The more we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven.

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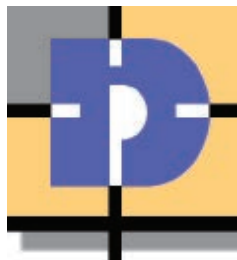
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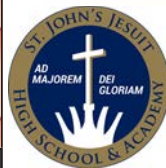


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
