Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent or by appointment.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at

419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish. Religious Life: Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

WORSHIP: Worship is the response of the People of God to the Father's invitation to be one with Him, expressed through the Church's official liturgy, as well as through other prayers and devotions. Our worship is direct to the Father, through the Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. All the ministries related to the prayer of the Church are included in this category.

A Note About the Notes—Our Gospel today, asks, "Will not God then secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night?" (Luke 18:7). The question is for emphasis. For even if the wicked and dishonest can answer the cry of the just, how could our good God not also do the same? Our closing hymn, "God of Day and God of Darkness" follows this same line of reasoning for social justice. "All creation still is groaning for the dawning of Your might, when the Sun of peace and justice fills the earth with radiant light." This beautiful hymn was written by Marty Haugen (who has written thousands of liturgical music) and set to the American hymn tune, "Beach Spring". "Beach Spring" is characterized for its bouncy yet

strong melody with a long tone always on the first beat, giving a dance-like pulse, and emphasizing the most important words. "Show us **Christ** in one **another**, make us **servants** strong and **true**; give us **all** your love of **justice** so we **do** what you would **do.**" --- Libby Saxton--Director of Music Ministries



Dear Brother in Christ,

As we prepare for World Mission Sunday on October 19, 2025, I am writing to urge you to encourage the faithful of your diocese in renewing its missionary commitment through prayer, preaching, and generous solidarity with the missions.

During my years as papal representative in missionary territories, I had the privilege of witnessing firsthand the extraordinary work made possible by The Pontifical Mission Societies. In Uganda, I was tasked with distributing over \$4 million in funds to support churches, clinics, schools, and pastoral programs. I saw with my own eyes what happens when the global Church steps forward in faith: children receive the sacraments, families find hope, and the Gospel takes on flesh and life.

Our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, who ministered for 22 years as a missionary in Peru, is clearly guiding the universal Church with the heart of a missionary. He has rightly called The Pontifical Mission Societies "the primary means for awakening missionary responsibility among all the baptized [and] supporting ecclesial communities in areas where the Church is young." As our chief missionary, he reminds us that mission is not a superfluous part of the Church's life — it is her very nature.

World Mission Sunday, established by Pope Pius XI in 1926, is a powerful expression of this identity. It is the only annual collection mandated by canon law for the universal Church (791.4). It is a moment for every parish, in every country, to focus on the missionary nature of our faith and to support the 1,124 mission territories that depend on the Pope for spiritual and material aid. World Mission Sunday is the opportunity for all of us to support our Holy Father in his apostolic responsibilities.

Last year alone, The Pontifical Mission Societies helped build nearly 1,000 churches, provided formation to 82,948 seminarians, supported more than 258,540 religious sisters, and equipped 843,785 catechists to evangelize in communities without a regular priestly presence.

I encourage you, dear brother, to preach about this sacred responsibility on World Mission Sunday, and to request your priests to do the same. Please ensure that your diocese promotes World Mission Sunday as a day of global prayer and giving — not just as "another second collection," but as a visible sign of our communion with those bringing Christ to the peripheries, conscious that the whole Catholic world counts on the generosity of the Church in the United States.
