Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent or by appointment.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244 -6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at 419-244 -6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish.

Religious Life: Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. If you are interested in this vocation, you can contact Sister Anthony Mary Diago at 419-214-4920.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419 -885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

A NOTE ABOUT THE NOTES

From Libby Saxton, Director of Music Ministry

Our preparation song today comes from Mary's Song or the Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55). It is a reminder of the celebration that is to come this week – the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. "The Canticle of the Turning" is set to a powerful Irish tune that really invokes the meanings of "turning." It is a nod to the revolution (derived from the Latin "volvere" which means "to turn") that Jesus preaches about in the Gospels and also the core message of repentance (to change oneself completely, or to "turn around"). The revolution is both an interior one (change of heart) and a community one (a new way of living together in Christian love and hope). As God promises to lift up the lowly and bring justice to the wronged, we find hope in the world getting caught up in this beautiful revolution of the Gospel. "My heart shall sing of the day you bring. Let the fires of your justice burn. Wipe away all tears, for the dawn draws near, and the world is about to turn!"(Canticle of the Turning, by Rory Cooney).

WINTER BIBLE STUDY


How Do I Live as a Christian in the Midst of a Pagan Culture? First Corinthians: The Church and the Christian Community





CELEBRATE ST. JUAN DIEGO

December 9

Baptized around the age 50, Juan Diego was walking to Mass on December 9, 1531, when Mary appeared to him on Tepeyac Hill, near Mexico City. Speaking in his native language of Náhuatl, she asked him to petition the bishop for a shrine to be built there. The bishop asked for a sign. On December 12, Juan returned to Tepeyac; Mary told him to pick flowers blooming atop the hill and put them in his cloak to take to the bishop. When Juan opened the cloak, the flowers fell out and the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe adorned his garment. This miraculous image is preserved in the famous basilica in Mexico City. He was canonized in 2002.

PARISH OPERATING FUND

2 SAINT JOSEPH PARISH SCHOOL ENDOWMENT FUND

3 RAINY DAY FUND

4 IRA CHARITABLE GIVING OPPORTUNITY

If you have reached the age of 70-1/2 you are eligible for what the IRS has deemed a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). A QCD allows you to give directly from your IRA to a qualifying charity, such as, Saint Joseph Parish, and the distribution is not counted as taxable income to you. We recommend that you consult with your investment advisor and/ or tax advisor if you have questions!

5 GIVING APPRECIATED SECURITIES

Many people that own appreciated investment securities want to use these as a way of making charitable donations. The tax benefit can be two-fold: 1) The value of your donation may be tax-deductible; 2) No capital gains taxes will be due on the increase in value over your cost basis. If you would like to make a donation to Saint Joseph Parish using appreciated securities, please notify our Business Manager, Heather Koziarski at 419-885-5791 and she can provide you with instructions for donating stock or mutual funds to our Parish.

6 ONLINE GIVING

This time of year is a great time to sign up for online giving. Online Giving gives you the opportunity to give to special collections in addition to regular offerings. You can choose to do a One-Time Gift of a special remembrance, or you can set up regularly scheduled contributions that are withdrawn on the date you specify in the system. 7 FACILITY FUND






