







Are you looking to get more out the Sunday Gospel? Are you hoping to add prayer into your Lenten devotion year?





Saint Joseph Parish Survey Results

In October, our parish invited the community to participate in a survey focused on hospitality, parishioner communication, and engagement in parish life. We are deeply grateful to everyone who took the time to respond. Since then, our staff and Pastoral Council have been carefully reviewing the results, praying with the feedback, and working to understand the themes, joys, and concerns that emerged. What follows is a summary of what we heard and how we are beginning to respond as we continue our shared mission together.

Demographics

A total of 390 participants took part in the survey. Of the respondents, 65% were female and 35% were male. The chart to the right provides a breakdown of the participants' age demographics.



Hospitality

Survey Results: Our parish environment is seen as warm, welcoming, and very positive by a large majority. Almost everyone views the parish environment positively. Over 75% of respondents rated it either a 4 or 5, showing strong satisfaction.

As you have read, most of our parishioners believe we have a warm and welcoming environment, but there is always room for improvement. If you have a gift of hospitality, please consider helping with a ministry to exercise that gift!



Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent or by appointment.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at 419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish.

Religious Life: Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. If you are interested in this vocation, you can contact Sister Anthony Mary Diago at 419-214-4920.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.


