

Climate change is an intense topic that is fundamentally science-based but also has significant political and ethical aspects. This talk will summarize background information about climate change, including the methods which have been used to characterize these changes. There will be a particular emphasis on the moral aspects of the issue and include the perspectives of religious leaders, including Pope Francis.

Dr. Jorgensen is a retired environmental chemist from the University of Toledo. His work on climate change education has been supported by NASA and the National Science Foundation.

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): The process of becoming Catholic involves faith formation and spiritual preparation leading to full initiation into the Church. It is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent, or by appointment.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at 419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish.

Matrimony: Couples planning to marry must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. Wedding dates and times may be set only after meeting with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has a prior civil or religious marriage, it must be resolved before a wedding date can be scheduled.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: If a parishioner is homebound due to age or illness, or is in a hospital or nursing facility, please contact the Parish Office to arrange Holy Communion or a pastoral visit. For serious illness or before surgery, request the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. For urgent needs, please call—do not email.

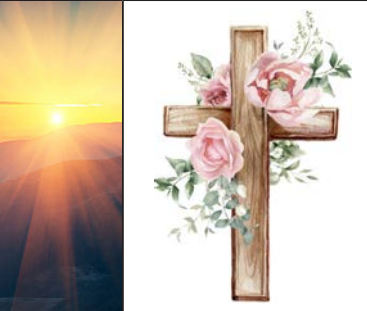
