*Are you feeling grateful for all that our parish priests ARE and DO for us?  
Would you like to help them become holier and healthier in body, mind and spirit?  
Perhaps you are feeling called to join the Seven Sisters Apostolate!*

**The Mission:** The Seven Sisters Apostolate strengthens the Church by offering a Holy Hour each day of the week for a specific priest or bishop—a "holy wasting" (cf. Mt. 26:10) of prayer for his deeper conformity to Christ.

**Seven Women:** A group forms when at least seven women respond to this call. The group coordinator is the Anchoress.

**One Priest:** The group prays for our pastor at Saint Joseph Sylvania and our parochial vicar. The intention is for the office of shepherd, not the individual; prayers pass to the successor when a priest is reassigned.

**One Hour, One Day:** Each member commits to one Holy Hour on a designated day each week, to be prayed at any time of the day. If unable to pray, she finds a substitute (not required to be a woman) or contacts the Anchoress.

**Holy Eucharist:** The Holy Hour is ideally prayed before the Blessed Sacrament - either in an Adoration Chapel or in front of a Tabernacle - but may be offered anywhere, allowing the commitment to be kept while traveling or with limited access.

**One Year:** The commitment is one hour per week for one year, typically June to June, the month of the Sacred Heart. (Feast of the Sacred Heart: June 12, 2026.)

# PLENARY INDULGENCES



## What is A Plenary Indulgence?

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. The indulgence applies to sins already forgiven. A plenary indulgence cleanses the soul as if the person had just been baptized.

Plenary indulgences obtained during the Special Jubilee Year of St. Francis can also be applied to souls in purgatory with the possibility of obtaining two plenary indulgences for the deceased in one day, according to the Apostolic Penitentiary.

## How to gain a plenary indulgence

This indulgence can be obtained, given the completion of the ordinary conditions (see below), through pilgrimages (including the holy sites designated for the Diocese of Toledo) or works of mercy and penance.

**Make a pious pilgrimage to one of the designated pilgrimage sites.** A pious visit includes:

- Spending a “suitable” amount of time during a prayerful visit in Eucharistic adoration, either in exposition or before the tabernacle, meditation, and concluding with praying for the intentions of Pope Leo XIV, the recitation of the Our Father, any legitimate form of the Creed, and invocations to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

## Ordinary conditions for plenary indulgence

To obtain any of the plenary indulgences the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- Detachment from all sin, even venial.
- Sacramental confession, holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope. These three conditions can be fulfilled a few days before or after performing the works to gain the indulgence, but it is appropriate that Communion and the prayer take place on the same day that the work is completed.
- A single sacramental confession is sufficient for several plenary indulgences, but frequent sacramental confession is encouraged to obtain the grace of deeper conversion and purity of heart.
- For each plenary indulgence that is sought, however, a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father are required.
- The prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father is left up to the choice of the individual, but an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):** The process of becoming Catholic involves faith formation and spiritual preparation leading to full initiation into the Church. It is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities.

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent, or by appointment.

**Matrimony:** Couples planning to marry must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. Wedding dates and times may be set only after meeting with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has a prior civil or religious marriage, it must be resolved before a wedding date can be scheduled.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** If a parishioner is homebound due to age or illness, or is in a hospital or nursing facility, please contact the Parish Office to arrange Holy Communion or a pastoral visit. For serious illness or before surgery, request the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. For urgent needs, please call—do not email.

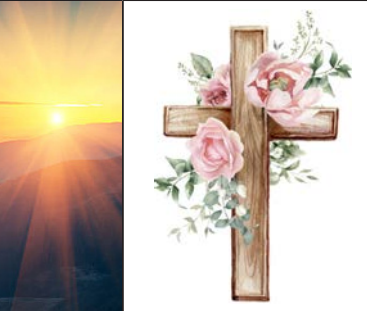
