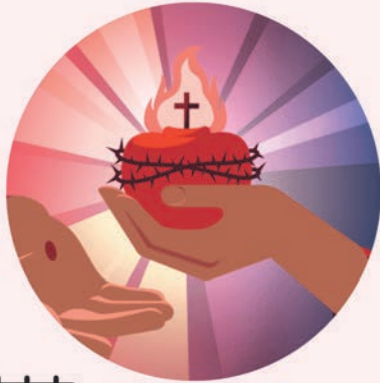

# Seven Sisters Apostolate

*Are you feeling grateful for all that our parish priests ARE and DO for us?  
Would you like to help them become holier and healthier in body, mind and spirit?  
Perhaps you are feeling called to join the Seven Sisters Apostolate!*

**The Mission:** The Seven Sisters Apostolate strengthens the Church by offering a Holy Hour each day of the week for a specific priest or bishop—a “holy wasting” (cf. Mt. 26:10) of prayer for his deeper conformity to Christ.

**Seven Women:** A group forms when at least seven women respond to this call. The group coordinator is the Anchoress.

**One Priest:** The group prays for our pastor at Saint Joseph Sylvania and our parochial vicar. The intention is for the office of shepherd, not the individual; prayers pass to the successor when a priest is reassigned.

**One Hour, One Day:** Each member commits to one Holy Hour on a designated day each week, to be prayed at any time of the day. If unable to pray, she finds a substitute (not required to be a woman) or contacts the Anchoress.

**Holy Eucharist:** The Holy Hour is ideally prayed before the Blessed Sacrament – either in an Adoration Chapel or in front of a Tabernacle - but may be offered anywhere, allowing the commitment to be kept while traveling or with limited access.

**One Year:** The commitment is one hour per week for one year, typically June to June, the month of the Sacred Heart. (Feast of the Sacred Heart: June 12, 2026.)

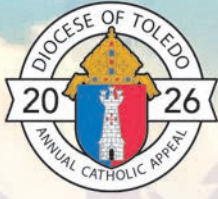

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):** The process of becoming Catholic involves faith formation and spiritual preparation leading to full initiation into the Church. It is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities.

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent, or by appointment.

**Holy Orders:** When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: [dkidd@toledodiocese.org](mailto:dkidd@toledodiocese.org), or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at 419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish.

**Religious Life:** Consecrated religious witness the joy of union with God and, freed from worldly cares, live fully for Him and others as signs of His Kingdom. To learn more about this vocation, contact Sister Anthony Mary Diago at 419-214-4920.

**Matrimony:** Couples planning to marry must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. Wedding dates and times may be set only after meeting with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has a prior civil or religious marriage, it must be resolved before a wedding date can be scheduled.

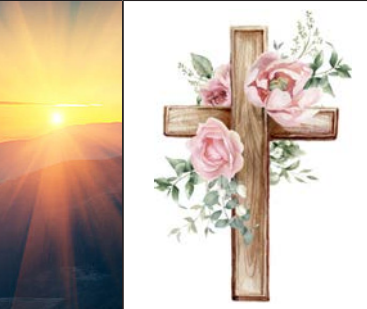
