Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent *or by appointment*.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at 419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish.

Religious Life: Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. If you are interested in this vocation, you can contact Sister Maria Amata, RSM, at

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

WORSHIP: Worship is the response of the People of God to the Father's invitation to be one with Him, expressed through the Church's official liturgy, as well as through other prayers and devotions. Our worship is direct to the Father, through the Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. All the ministries related to the prayer of the Church are included in this category.





Dear Saint Joseph Parishioners,

When I first arrived at our parish in July 2022, I mentioned in my opening greeting at each of the Lord's Day Masses that a verse from the Gospel of John had been reoccurring to me before arriving at our parish. In John chapter 17, Jesus prays to the Father during His priestly prayer at The Last Supper regarding His disciples: "Father, they are Your gift to me." These words of Jesus had become my own before arriving at our parish, for in them

I found that the Lord's words were supplying my own in gratitude to God for all of you even before meeting you; "Father, they are Your gift to me."

In ways that only He in His generosity could make possible, I have come to know these words of Jesus more profoundly and more clearly over the three years that I have been chosen by Him to serve you as His priest. You have been a gift to me from God; through offering myself for you to come to know and love Him more, I have come to see the beauty of lives that come to God in every moment of life. In particular, seeing you adore Jesus, our Hidden God in the Eucharist, has made me a better priest; for in seeing you adore our Lord, I have grown in surrendering more fully to the God who does not abandon us.

As I now leave our parish, the words of Jesus again bring me confidence and joy; "Father, they are Your gift to me." I am grateful to God for all of you, because each of you is a gift. To the Giver of all goodness, we in turn must surrender our hearts, even if they may be weak or sinful, in gratitude and in petition for the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of His Mother to triumph in each of us.

My prayers for you before our Lord, especially in the Eucharist, are guaranteed; please pray for me to be a holier priest when you are before Jesus in the Eucharist, because your prayers are a gift to me.

A Note about the Notes--This weekend, you will hear a couple of Father Joseph's favorite hymns. They are gems that can be sung straight from the heart. "O Sacrament Most Holy" is our communion meditation hymn this weekend and it originated from Rome in the 19th century. Although that is not that old in the history of the Catholic Church, this hymn quickly became a favorite worldwide for its repeated refrain and adoration of Jesus in the

Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist. The first four verses follow the same formula, praising and thanking Jesus for giving Himself to us in the Eucharist. Then, the last verse is really special, calling out to those who might need Jesus the most, calling them to the Eucharistic feast to bring wholeness and healing to all peoples: "O come, all you who labor in sorrow and in pain; come, eat this bread from heaven; your peace and strength regain."


